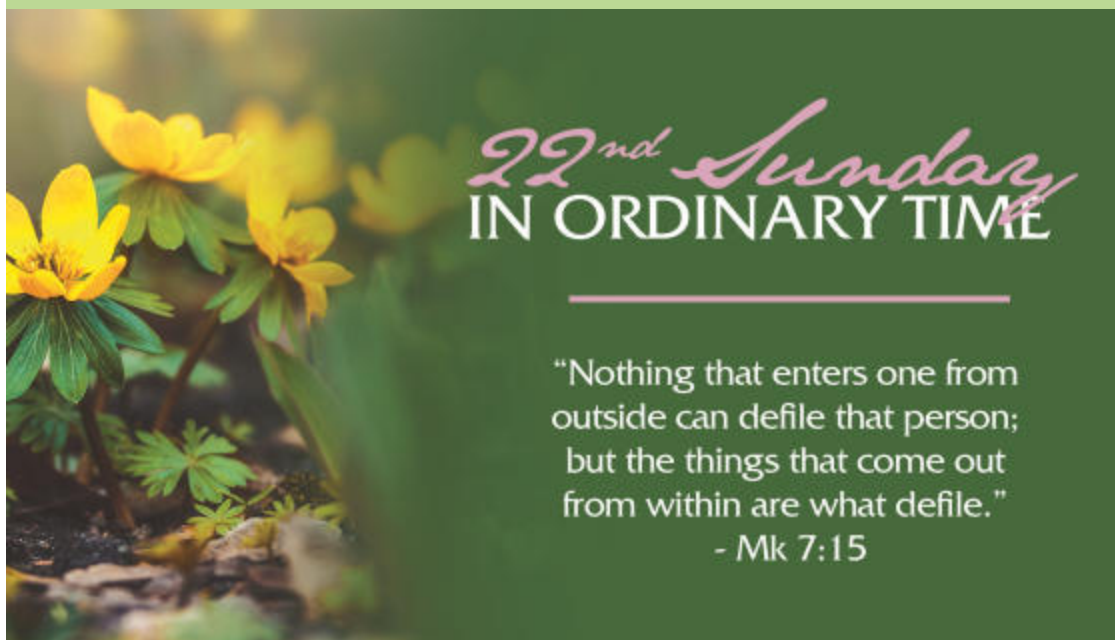

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last Sunday, I was in South Bend to celebrate my parent's 50th wedding anniversary. I said Holy Mass at Holy Family parish my childhood church and school. After Holy Communion, I blessed their marriage. May the Lord Jesus bless all married couples throughout the world and may couples receive the powerful intercession of Mary, who helped the married couple at the Wedding of Cana, to have a daily increase in joy and love in the Holy Spirit and Blood of Christ.

I have been asked to say the First Saturday Mass on Saturday, September 4th, at the Our Lady, Mother of Mercy Center, in Rome City. Confessions at 9:30am and Mass at 11:00am. All are welcome.

August 28th is the Feast of Saint Augustine, a foundational Catholic thinker. He was a truth seeker, but also a pleasure seeker. The prayers of his mother, Saint Monica, and the preaching of the bishop Saint Ambrose won out. Augustine was baptized, became a priest, and eventually became a bishop in Hippo, Africa. He developed a community of priests who lived with him as he prayed and shepherded his diocese. One of his most quoted lines is: "Every saint has a past and every sinner has a future."

Augustine's most famous book is his "Confessions," which is the world's first autobiography.

This week, let's each of us get to Confession. Let's turn around. Let's live differently. Let's think differently. Let's seek out on the adventure of beholding the Truth, which is not a thing but a Person — Jesus Christ. May we embrace him fully and wholeheartedly, personally and together.
