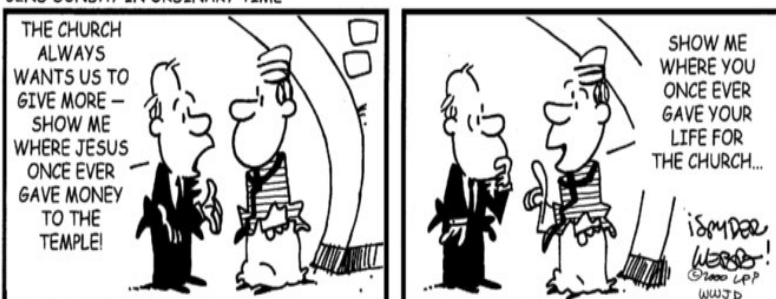
#iGiveCatholic 2021

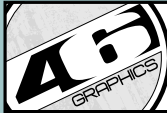
