BOX OF JOY MINISTRY

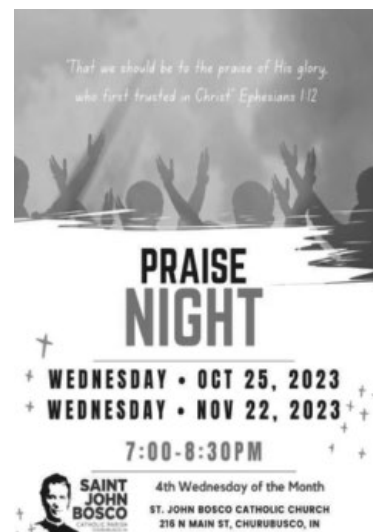

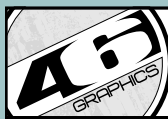

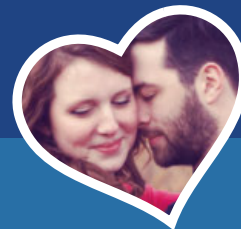
