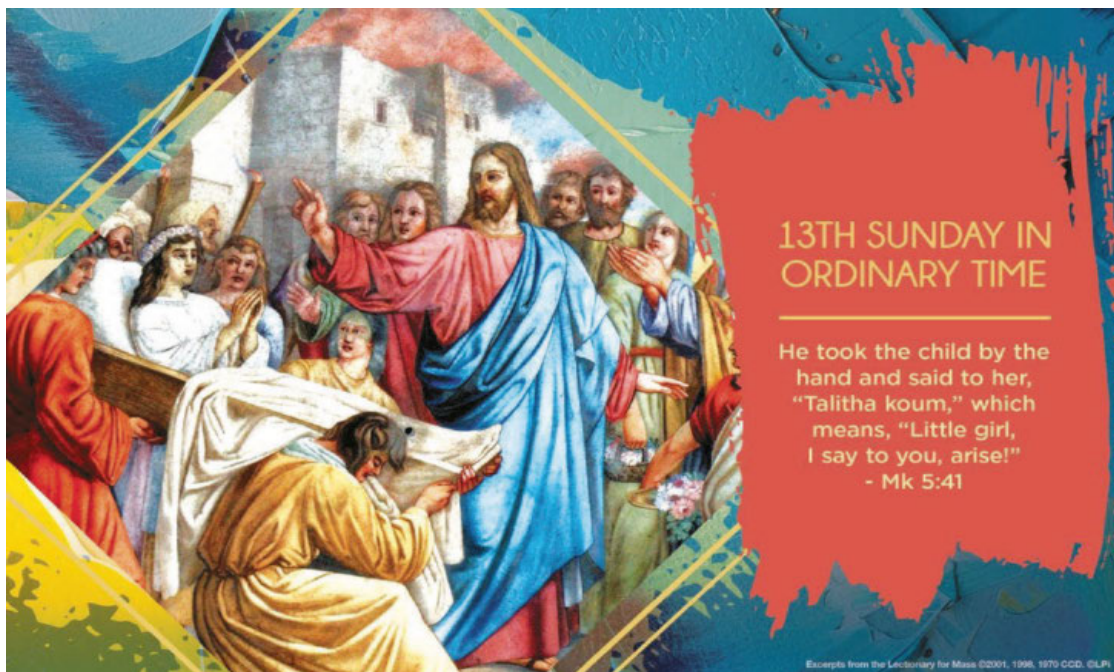

From Father Keeton

Faith and Trust

God, who formed us in His imperishable image, did not intend for us to die, as we hear in our First Reading. Death entered the world through the devil's lies and Adam and Eve's actions to believe those lies. As a result of Original Sin, we are all bound to die an earthly death. But in our Gospel, we see Jesus liberate a little girl from the stranglehold of death. Jesus has power over the natural death of the body. But also, this Gospel shows us that we should have hope that we too will be raised from the dead, along with our loved ones, if we have lived and died for Christ and not for our own sins.

We are called to have the same faith as the parents of the girl. Notice that her parents follow and trust in Jesus even though everyone else says that there is no hope. Parents know that there is hope. We are asked to pray for our loved ones who have died a physical death, and also for those who may be spiritually dead because they are apart from God.

God does not ask, nor command the impossible. His grace helps us to fulfill His commandments. "What God commands, He makes possible by His grace" (CCC 2082).

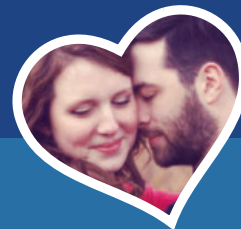

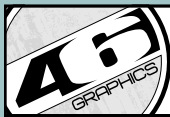
