

Why are you Here?

The crowds have followed Jesus to His next destination because they were looking for something. Thus, Jesus asks them, in a way, why they were seeking Him out. It is a good thing to seek Christ. However, it is revealed that the crowds were seeking Christ for the wrong reasons they were physically hungry again and desired more free bread and fish. We also see this in our First Reading with the Israelites that they were not satisfied and wanted more. Thus, it is the same in our life that, at times, we are not satisfied and desire more more wealth, more house, more cars, more material good, better food, fancier furniture, more experiences or activities or vacations, etc. These material and worldly things do not satisfy and if they are not kept in their appropriate place, then they will consume us and leave us with an unquenchable thirst that desires more and more of an action, experience, or material object. Thus, St. Paul tells us in our Second Reading that we are to not be like the Gentiles who seek satisfaction in the world, but instead to be like Christ and be satisfied in the things of heaven. And so the question for each of us is: "Why are you here?" What is your reason for seeking out Jesus? What is it that you hope to get from Him? What will satisfy your desires and for how long?
