Christ Himself through the Sacraments

God knows that we need to experience Him tangibly, through our senses, because we are human beings and that is part of the way He created us. This is precisely how God chooses to give Himself to us through the Sacraments: flowing water, perfumed oil, touch of hands, audible words, and bread and wine to sustain us. Without food, we become irritable and frustrated as Elijah did on his journey and as the Israelites did during their travels through the desert. Just as earthly food enables our bodies to keep living, the Eucharist enables us to have divine life, both in this life and in the next. Christ has chosen to not become something that we just look at and admire, but instead someone that we receive. He desires intimacy with us, and every time we receive Him, especially in the Holy Eucharist, we experience a taste of eternal union with Him.

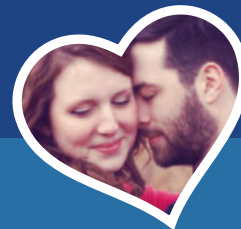

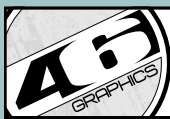
