"Heart Value"

Two extraordinary women feature in our readings today. The woman in the first reading (1 Kings 17:10-16), the widow at Zarephath, is extraordinary because during a famine she trusted enough in God's prophet Elijah to share with him the last bread she baked for herself and her son with her last flour and oil. As the prophet had predicted, there was a miraculous multiplication miracle, and her flour and oil did not run out and she had enough bread for herself and her son for a year. The woman in the Gospel is extraordinary in her generosity as she gave her two small coins to a collection in the temple (Mark 12:38-44). What she gave was miniscule. In Mark's Greek it is clear what those two small coins were and together they were worth only 1/64th of a daily wage! Even though the economic value of what she gave was tiny, the "heart value," was colossal. What she gave, she gave with her heart.

God looks at the heart, not appearances. One of the beatitudes is, "Blessed are the pure in heart." Being pure in heart means appearances match what is inside and are not just appearances like those of the scribes. May we be pure in heart before God.




