Our Journey Through Advent

Last week, we celebrated Christ the King of the Universe in which we declared with one voice that Jesus reigns supreme in our life, that He is the one and only God that we serve, and that we allow Him to direct our words and actions every day. Today, we celebrate the beginning of Advent, the season of preparation to welcome the King of the Universe into our hearts and souls in a special way on Christmas day! Use these four weeks that lie ahead of us to ease yourself into the season of Christmas. Take each week of Advent to take another step along the journey to becoming one with Christ Jesus!

Our Advent Wreath has four candles on it and shows us how to progress through Advent. It is a progression through Advent, which is why we do not light all the candles at once, but instead, one at a time to help us to build up our spiritual muscles and make preparations each week for the coming of the Lord on Christmas, into our lives. The three purple candles of the Advent Wreath represent: prayer, fasting, and penance. The one rose candle represents rejoicing and giving thanks to God. The candles help to light our way toward Christmas so that we can see where we are going and how to get there.

The first candle calls us to deepen our prayer life during the first week of Advent. We are asked to examine what we are already doing and to see about taking it one step further this week. Maybe that is spending ten extra minutes in prayer each day from now until Christmas. Or maybe that is arriving at church and being seated at least ten minutes before Mass begins so that way, we can prepare ourselves to receive Jesus at the celebration. Or maybe it is praying a decade of the Rosary each day, or doing some spiritual reading, or listening to a spiritual talk on TV or on YouTube. There are many, different, small ways that we can take our prayer to the next level, and help our family to take their prayer to the next level also. For example, maybe we start to pray together as a family every night before we go to bed. Just five minutes together before bed. And we keep up this prayer routine throughout all of Advent and then into the rest of our life.


