Fasting Builds on Prayer

The second candle of Advent represents fasting. We look at what we can do in order to separate ourselves from those things that we may enjoy too much of. For example, maybe we decide that we will not have any desserts from now until Christmas so that way, I can enjoy the spiritual sweetness of Christmas along with the baked good sweetness of Christmas on Christmas Day. Or maybe I say no to desserts during the week. Or maybe it is reducing my TV or internet usage each day so as to make more room for God in my life. We choose something to fast from the second Week of Advent in order to free a part of us to spend more time with God that week. We say no to a desire of the flesh in order to say yes to God. This allows us to have more time to spend with God in prayer, and to see that He satisfies our desires, not the things of the world. So, this week, examine yourself and see what you can fast from, what you can detach yourself from, in order to become attached to God. That way, you will have room in your heart to welcome the Christ Child on Christmas Day!

Mary is a great example for us to follow in this guidance, and we celebrate her on Monday December 9 for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, which is a Holy Day of Obligation (it was moved this year because it fell on a Sunday). Thus, we ask Mary to assist us to make room in our heart, and in our lives, to welcome Christ to dwell within us.
