## PENANCE-TO MAKE UP FOR THE TIMES WE HAVEN'T LOVED GOD

The fourth candle of Advent represents penance. The week leading up to Christmas, we are asked to undergo some sort of penance, some extra thing that we place onto ourselves in order to build up those spiritual muscles. This can also be called a sacrifice or giving up something. Fasting is a reduction or a reducing of something that we are already currently doing, but a sacrifice is the act of completely getting rid of something present in your life. For example, fasting from dessert means a reduction in the frequency or amount of dessert that I currently consume, but a giving up of dessert means no more dessert, period. This last week of Advent, we are asked to give up something that we are holding onto that we should not be. We are asked to pick a sin that is present in our life and to say that, starting the beginning of the fourth week of Advent, we will say no to this sin for the rest of our life. And we will be able to because we have already been practicing extra, deeper prayer, and have been practicing fasting by reducing something else in our life. Week by week, we have been building up our spiritual muscles to, eventually, say no to a sin that is a frequent visitor of our life. Little by little, we journey through Advent to prepare ourselves to be holier, better people in order to welcome Christ into our lives.

- 1. Book of the Dead was well received and will be placed by the memorial candles next November

- 4. Music ministry is in development and looking to rearrange their set up in 2025 to better serve the program and our music ministers
