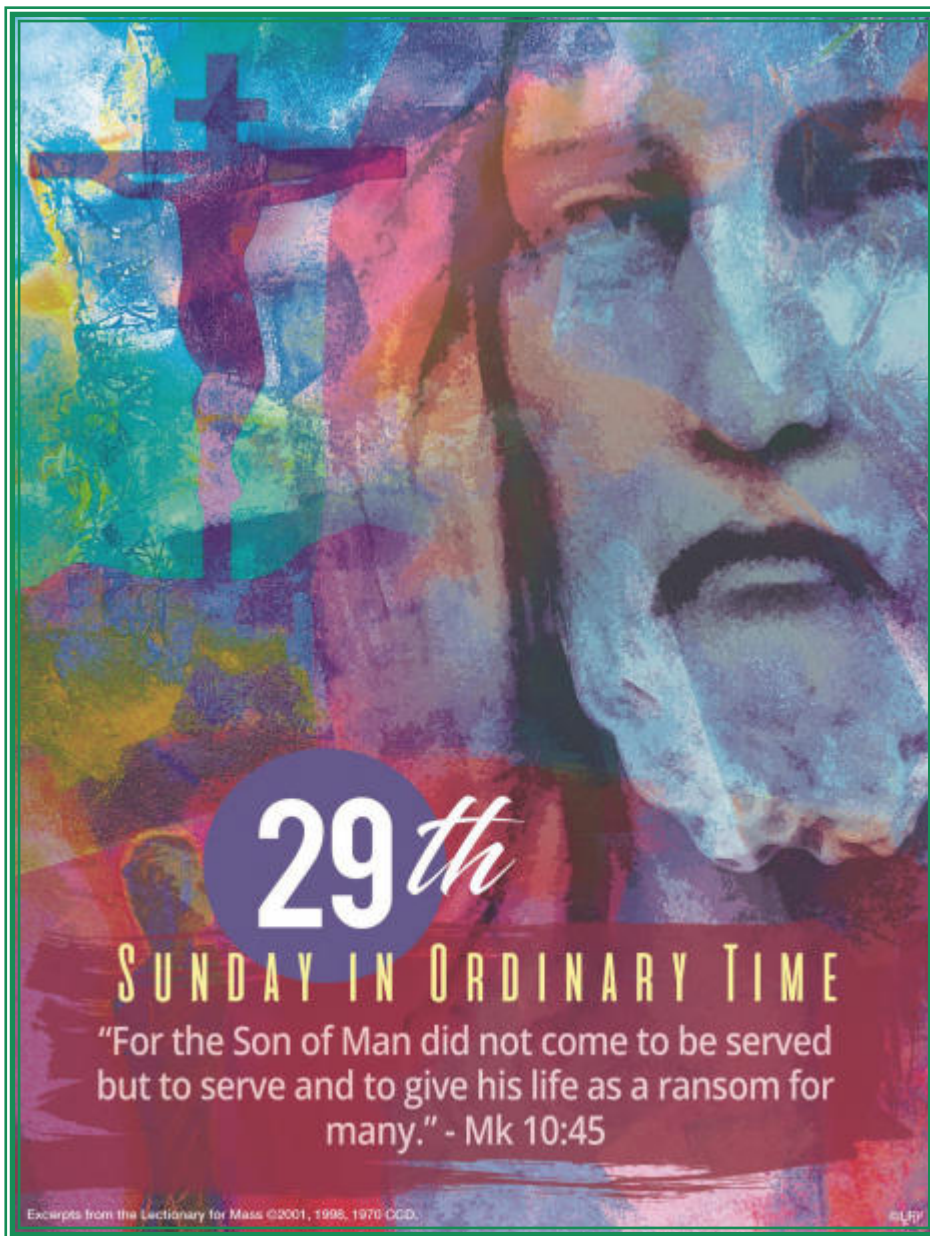

# 29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

October 21, 2018

## **"But it shall not be so among you" Mk 10:41**

Last Sunday there were seven more people added to the official ranks of the saints. These were people who lived dynamic lives of faith. I am aquatinted with the lives of three of them. Shortly after I was ordained I served with the sister's community of the Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ in Chicago. They were founded by recently canonized St. Mary Katherine Kasper. She lived in Germany in the late 19<sup>th</sup> Century. To this very day, the sisters carry on her humble care for the poor in the United States, Mexico, India, Kenya, and Brazil. St. Pope Paul VI worked to implement the Second Vatican Council particularly in promoting evangelization and social justice in developing nations throughout the world. St. Oscar Romero was a champion in promoting the rights of the poor in El Salvador in the 1980s during government hostilities against the Church that ministered to the poor.

This week we hear in the Gospel another challenge on the perception of greatness and ambition in discipleship. We heard a comparable passage in Mark's Gospel some weeks ago. Both of these stories on the debate on greatness occur after Jesus announced His mission of His death and Resurrection. This suggests to us that greatness is grounded in the death and Resurrection of Jesus. A clear observable demonstration of the Pascal mystery is service. It is seen in the great example of the saints particularly those who were canonized last week.

The story of James and John in this week's Gospel teaches us that a true sense of service is grounded in the mystery of Christ's death and rising. It is an invitation to share in the cross of Christ. Living the Gospel is not motivated on an award system but the joy of living in Christ.

November 11 is commitment Sunday for the Archdiocesan United Catholic Appeal. We thank Christina Tuley for her words last weekend on behalf of the Archdiocese. It is very inspiring to know how many services the Archdiocese provides. The Appeal is a moment when we appreciate that there is so much that the Archdiocese does for the benefit of the people. Our parish has a goal of \$18,600. In reaching this goal we will actively support the pastoral life of the local Church in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. We will show the Appeal video on November 3 and 4 to further inspire us by seeing the great work of our Archdiocese.

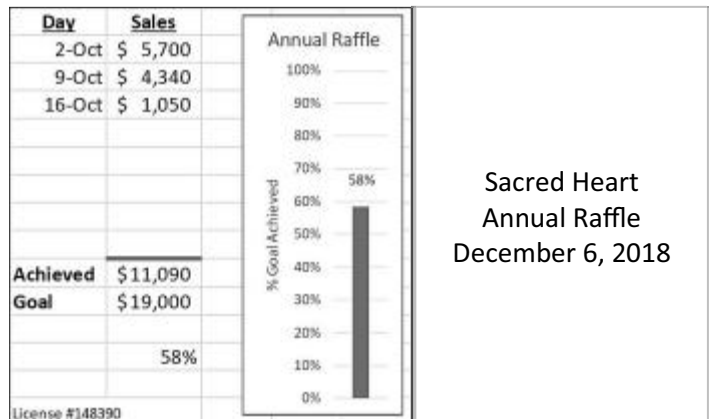
