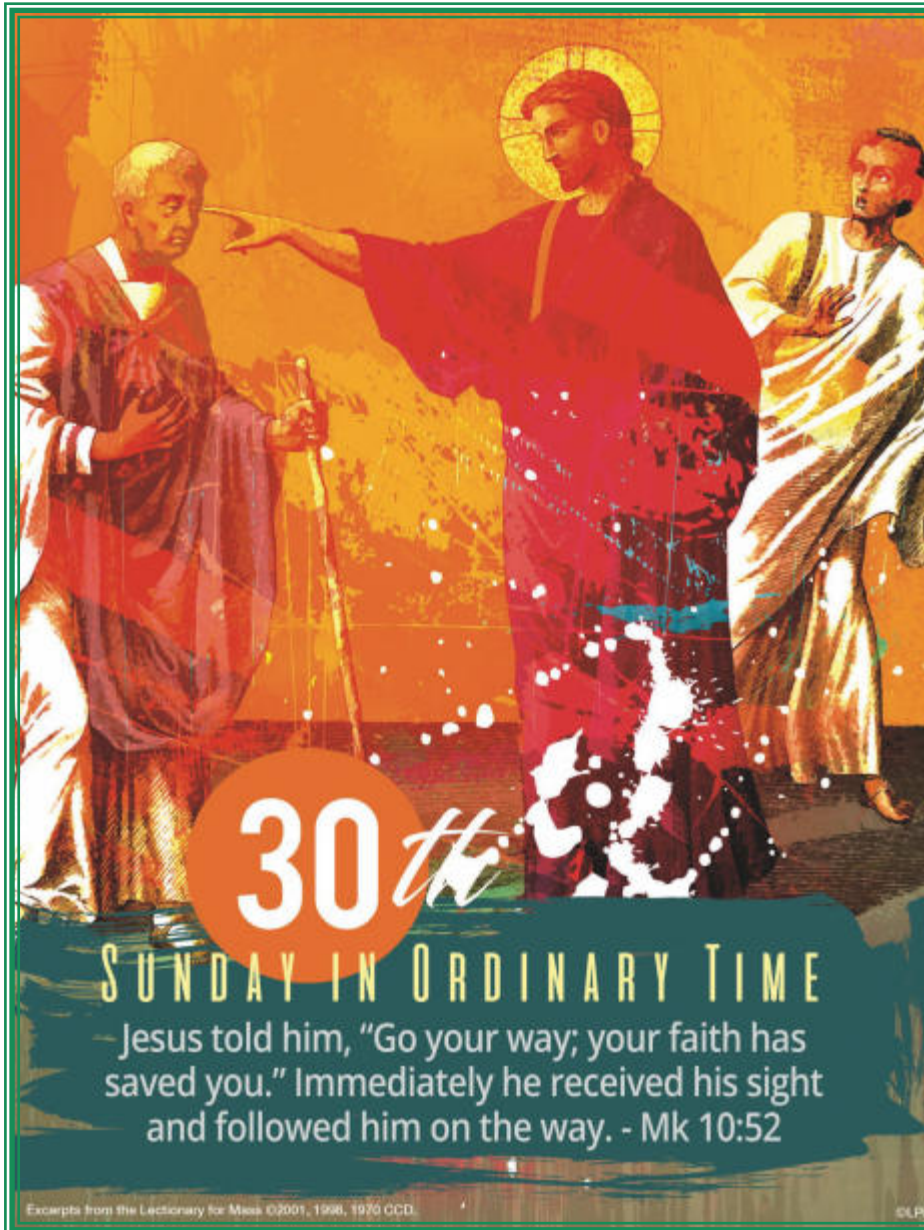

October 28, 2018

"Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the way." MK 10:52

The concept of sight has a number of meanings. One meaning is physical sight. We often take our ability to see for granted. I can imagine how depressing and difficult it would be not to be able to see. I think many of us who had cataract surgery will recall the process of recovery. A couple of hours after surgery, on the removal of the bandage, it almost felt like being born again. It felt good to see more clearly.

Another meaning of sight is our ability to think clearly or to have insight. Often we refer to our faith that gives us vision. We talk about seeing the light. In the Gospel story today Jesus gives the blind beggar sight and he began to follow Jesus. Through his healing, he was given the ability to recognize Jesus.

Perhaps on hearing this week's Gospel, we can reflect on the ways that our faith gives us sight. We may look to the practice of our faith, particularly in prayer for ways of dealing with the challenges of our lives. Often we turn to prayer when we have concerns about our health, our relationships, the well being of our family, or our financial situation.

Our faith also calls us to be more aware of our social responsibilities and how we are influenced by Catholic Social Teaching. Election Day is a few days away. It is a time to ask God for guidance and insight. We gain insight the more we educate ourselves on our Catholic Social Teaching. We work with familiarizing ourselves with important issues. We can put into perspective things like fear, self interest, or party loyalty. Sometimes these things can make us blind to the promotion of the common good.

In this week's Gospel we hear that after the blind beggar's sight was restored, he followed Jesus. As we are grounded in following Jesus our faith gives us sight to bring a faith perspective to the reality of our personal and social lives.
