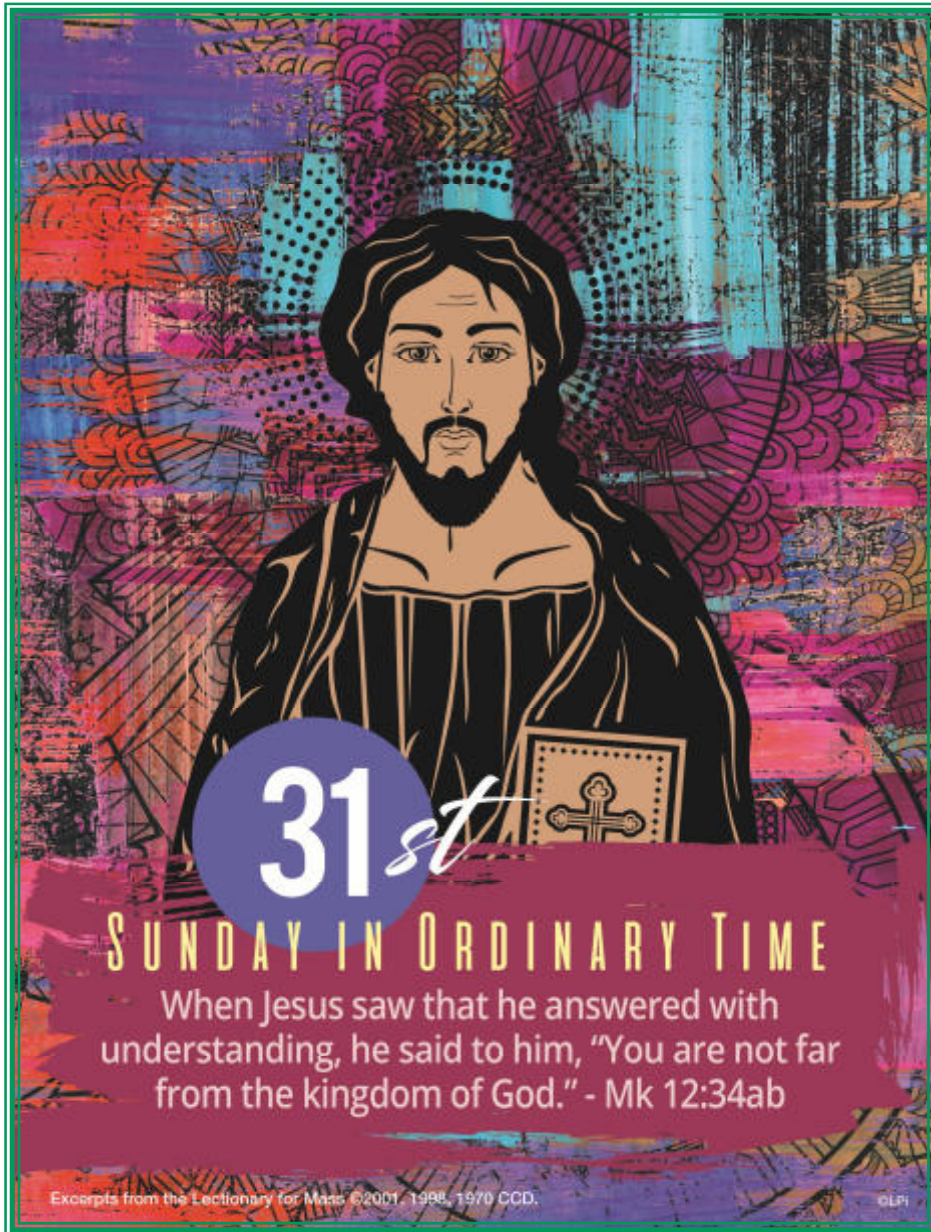

## To Be a Saint

The Catechism of the Catholic Church quotes Lumen Gentium, one of the documents of Vatican II: "The Church...is held, as a matter of faith, to be unfailingly holy." (par. 39) It goes on to say that "The Church then, is 'the holy People of God' (par. 12), and her members are called "saints." (Acts 9:13) In a following paragraph, the Catechism again quotes the document: "The Church on earth is endowed already with a sanctity that is real though imperfect." (par. 48)

We also read that the Church recognizes the power of the Holy Spirit among her members which allows some to lead a life in union with God. These holy people are canonized as saints and are a model for us. Having just celebrated the holyday of All Saints, this gives us pause to consider our relation to the saints, especially in our Franciscan tradition. In our Church we have statues of St. Francis, St. Anthony, St. Bonaventure, and a window dedicated to Blessed John Duns Scotus. I encourage you to explore these saints – their lives, their teaching, their witness and preaching. There is much that we can learn from them.

St. Francis started out as a person of his time and his city. He enjoyed life, wanted to be a knight, and worked with his father in selling cloth. In his youth, he responded to the presence of God in his life and decided to follow God more closely. His first choice was to encounter God in solitariness. He went to an abandoned church, he spent time in caves alone with God and he went up into the mountains. He made time and space for God in his life.

Enchanted with love of God, Francis began to share – simply and briefly – the joy he experienced at the saving power of God. Some people rejected him, but many were impressed, not so much by his words but by his demeanor and the way he treated others. As a result, many men and women were drawn into their own deep relationships with God. The Church was rebuilt through the example of one man and his willingness to share God's work in him.

It is clear from the first paragraph above that we are all called to do something similar to what Francis did, for it is a pattern followed by many saints. Our baptism joins us to the communion of saints and evokes from us the same journey of faith. Where do you encounter God? Where is your church, cave or mountain? Do you stand before God in the fullness of your being, in all honesty, and allow the wonder of God's saving power to change you? May you seek and find the same joy that Francis experienced in his quest for holiness. May you be recognized as a saint among the saints of God.

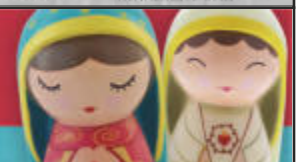
