Fr. Duc's Musings – Moving forward

With this musing, I would like to update you on what has been happening at Sacred Heart as we continue to move out of pandemic procedures and towards the 2025 Jubilee.

- **Mercy Meals:** Once again we are able to offer Mercy Meals for those who a loved one has passed into eternal life. Recognizing the importance of this ministry, the Mercy Meal is 100% funded by Sacred Heart for a bereaved family. We do not charge anything whether you are a parishioner or not. The funding for this ministry has been provided from generous benefactors and is directly paid from the parish operating fund (like anything important, we put it in the budget and don't need to run fund raiser for the fund to be available). We give thanks to the ministers of bereavement: those who work to prepare a family for the funeral liturgy (John & Veronica Sauter) and those who console mourners through a meal (Rose Pittman, Mary Sturm, Nancy Hamilton, Arleen Krebs, and many others).
- **Pastoral Council & Finance Council:** We now have reestablished both councils.
 - The Pastoral Council has been working on envisioning our parish in light of a new Pastoral Plan from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis (Proclaiming the Gospel of Joy: Living Christ's Mission). In addition, the P.C. will be looking at updating our database of parishioners as well as the creation of a new parish directory so that we can stay in better communication as the 2025 Jubilee approaches.
 - The Finance Council has been keeping the parish financially sound and is working on ways to guide the parish in repairs and fundraising. The F.C. is overseeing the Chapel Refreshment Committee and the soon to be established committee to repair the church towers and other structural issues as reported by Arsee Engineering (more to come).
- **Liturgy:**
 - With the pandemic and the completion of Br. Gary's assignment at Sacred Heart, we have simplified our Masses so that we can still worship together in a spirit of joy while searching for a Liturgy Director and to replenish our ministerial pool. The 5pm Mass has been simplified to having a cantor from our parish with accompaniment offered by the many musicians that we have hired. Let us give thanks to Rose Carr and Christina Tuley who have provided us with beautiful singing. The 8am and 10am Masses were combined into a 9am Mass that were held together with a combination of parishioners (the choir when we can gather them) and hired accompanists. With the assistance of Joe Miller, the choir also came together to provide beautiful for Midnight Mass and throughout Holy Week and Easter. We are particularly thankful for Anne Raway, Pam & Walt Seal, Oscar Otero, and Ria Periera for their contribution this past year. One of the more important works that Br. Gary did for the parish is to coordinate with the Liturgy Committee to select music, planning the arts and environment and to assign musicians to the Masses. That work has been heroically taken up by Veronica Sauter, Christina Tuley, Judith Essex and Karen Kuehn. As we move into the future, the parish is establishing a new position to do what Christina has been doing for the last year (selecting music, assigning musicians and cantors, communicating with musicians, reporting usage for copyrighted materials, and submitting payment requests for hired musicians). That position (person) is called a Liturgy Coordinator Minister. It is a part-time position to do the administrative work needed for Liturgies. The parish is offering that position to Clare Hughes for the fiscal year of 2021-2022. Clare will only be able to work for us until she enters college next year.
 - The parish is currently working with ministers to renew our Liturgy for the Children program. It is my desire that we create an integrated approach to formation in the parish so that we have programs for all ages of life. Revisiting the Liturgy for the Children is only a beginning to this integration.
- **Events:** So many parishioners commented on how much joy they experienced at the Jubilee celebrations for those who were 75+ years as a member of the parish and for the Franciscan Friars who celebrated 25+ years jubilees as religious. We are providing more opportunities to get together to know one another and have some fun. Check elsewhere in the bulletin for future events. In particular after the Masses on the 2nd and 4th weekend of the month (weather permitting), we will have refreshment in the parking lot as well as a table for Fr. Duc's Trading Post (item exchange). On July 25th the parish will have the last opportunity to wish Br. Gary a good transition. There will be a gathering at 10am in the friary to say farewell. On July 30th we have Karaoke #2 Potluck from 6 to 8pm at SH Hall. Some of these events will need registration on-line or by calling the Parish Office so that we can prepare adequately for your presence.

As you can see, there have been a lot of changes in the parish to move us forward. I would like to invite you to pray for the success of these endeavors, to participate, to offer financial tithing, and to contribute services towards helping the parish to grow in various ways. May the Lord bless us all with a generous heart.
