BEREAVEMENT / GRIEVING



What Everyone Should Know About the First Year of Grief #6

Getting through the first year after the death of a loved one can feel like a "landscape without gravity... there are no road maps to guide us through this fresh grief". But others have walked this unknown before us and can share what they have learned. In the next few weeks we will explore some of these insights.

The first year of grief does not flow neatly from one "stage" to the next, rather it is a time expressed by fluctuating cycles, lots of ups and downs and can surprise

you in many ways. We will take some time to explore what you might expect in this first year of grief.

Take your time, but do your grief work: During early grief, you may want to stay busy all the time, avoiding painful emotions and exhausting work of grief, hoping time will heal you. There's no set schedule and no recovery period for grief. But time alone does not heal...it's what we do with the time that counts. Take the time you need to do your grief work. But also take time away from grieving to do things you enjoy, to rest and replenish. When a loved one dies, our hoped-for future dies too. Beginning in this first year, and continuing on from there, living with your loss means taking on new roles, new relationships, a new future; without forgetting the past. Sometimes, life takes surprising turns. Confronted with loss, we can weave the strands of our past into a new, meaningful future we never would have planned to live. Doing so is a conscious choice.

Your loved one's spirit and your continuing bond of love gives you strength each day. Your loved one is there to help you during this painful first year, and in all the years to come. Trust that God in His infinite wisdom and love carries you through your journey forward. *Taken from thoughts shared by Kay Talbot Ph.D., grief counselor and author of Abbey Press CareNotes; "What Everyone Should Know About the First Year of Grief"*

It is a positive, renewing experience for couples that have a good marriage, but want to make it even better! This is a time for you and your spouse to spend time together and learn



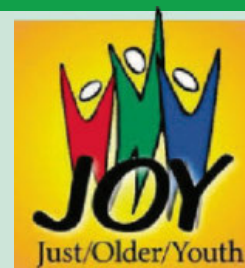
