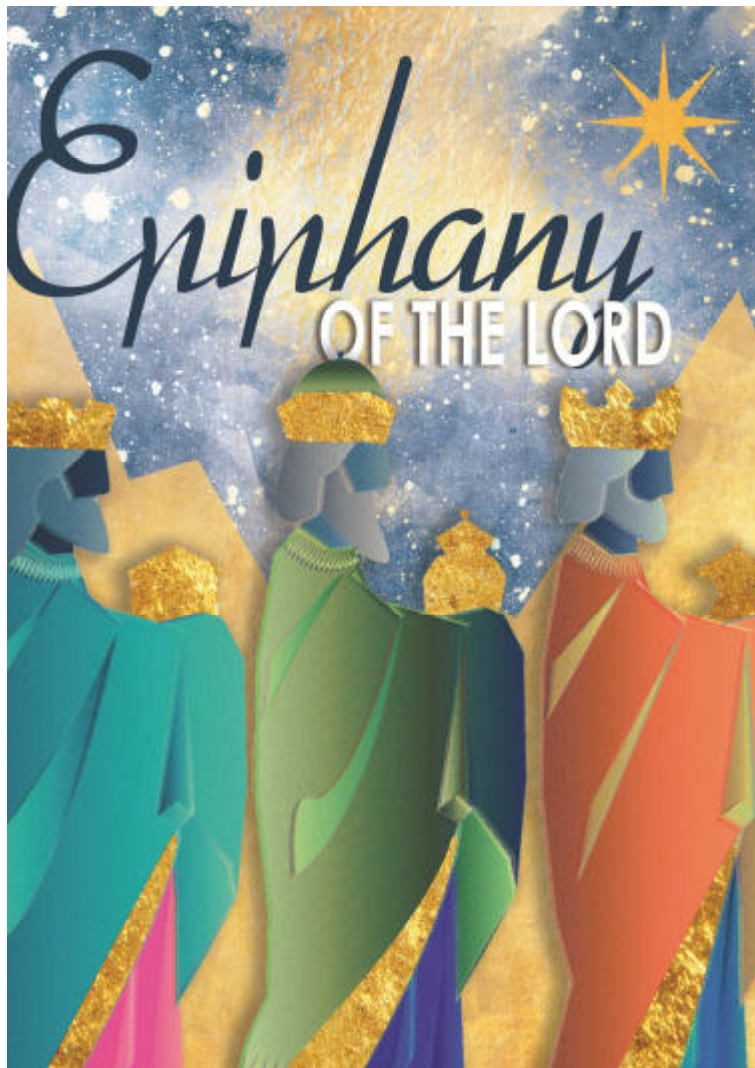

Gospel Reflections... Epiphany 2018 Evangelization through Gift Giving

Gift giving for evangelization can be misinterpreted that we are bribing someone to like us or our cause. This is not, of course how we interpret the Magi giving gifts to Jesus, they see it as genuine praise and adoration. When we give gifts to God, we are simply giving back a small portion of the gifts He gives us.

Recently a good idea was floated to complete a goal of our 4 parish joint pastoral council. How can we evangelize with food while also caring for the hungry? The idea is simple, plant a couple of gardens at our parishes, weed and water and let

God give us the gifts. Then we get together in late summer and make meatless spaghetti sauce and salsa out of these vegetable gifts. Then put this into small canning jars and place on them a scripture passage and contact information for our parishes. Next we recruit some church members to go out into neighborhoods and give these away. Instead of going to doors asking for something, we are simply giving a gift.

If people want to talk to us more, we explain that our relationship with God is all gift and so our best way of representing God is by giving a gift. Our church will represent God well and have our share of members as we make it Epiphany all year round.

If you are interested in joining into this idea, contact me or Mark Othmer and we can start planning this winter.
