The four Gospels tell us the life of the Lord Jesus, which every Christian must know.

In short, the life of Jesus was like this: Jesus was born in Bethlehem and was placed in a manger, wrapped in swaddling clothes; the shepherds went there to adore him, and the angels sang: "Glory to God in heaven and peace on earth to men of good will." Then the Magi from the East went to adore him. King Herod wanted to kill the Child, and Saint Joseph and the Virgin fled with Him to Egypt. Later they returned to Nazareth where Jesus grew up and worked as an artisan in the workshop of Joseph, giving us an example of sanctifying family life and work that must be well done and pleasing to God.

Then, for three years, he preached his doctrine, the one he taught us from Heavenly Father, and he went about doing good, with many miracles, showing that he was God and that he was coming to save us. Because he loved us, he instituted the Holy Eucharist and made priests of the Apostles, and then began his painful Passion until he was nailed to the Cross; Thus he redeemed us, that is, he paid the heavenly Father with the price of his blood and his life, for all the sins of Adam and Eve and their descendants, that we are all the men and women of the world.

Jesus died, he was put in a sepulcher, but on the third day he rose again and appeared alive and glorious to the holy women and the Apostles; at forty days he ascended to Heaven, promising that he would send to them the Holy Spirit.

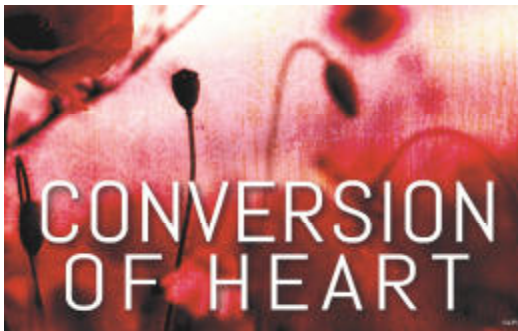
