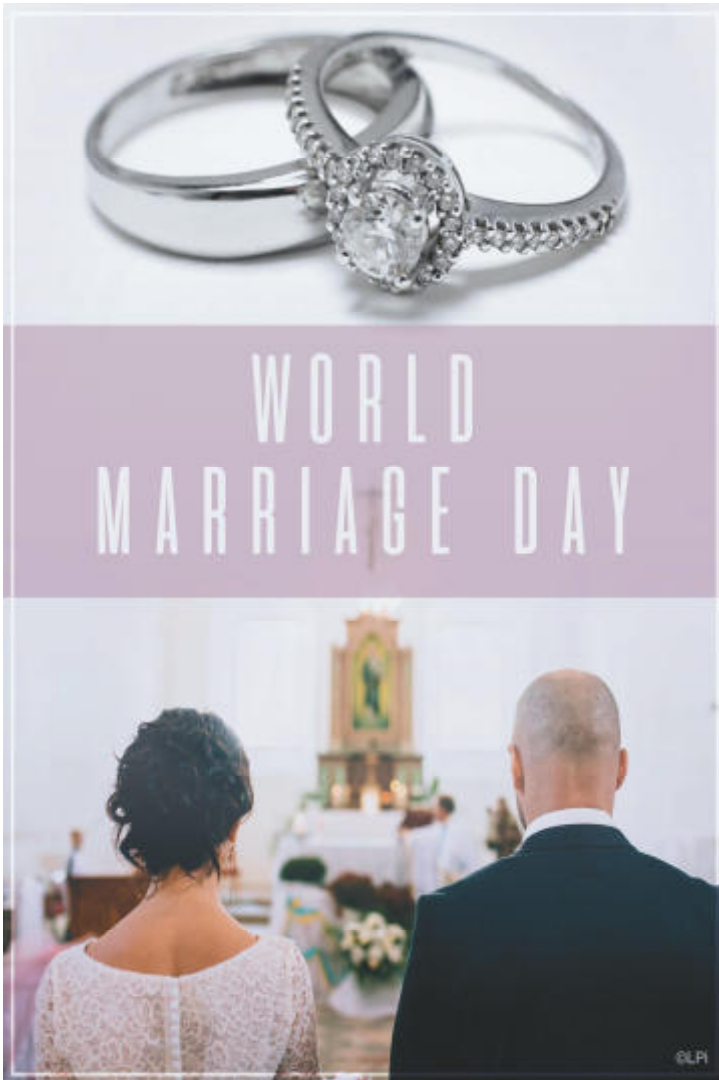

Gospel Reflections... How can I find God?

There he left it for two days, without allowing him to drink water. Then they went where the town's river was born, and said:

At this moment, to survive you need water. How would you do it?

The man knelt, and lowering his head he drank from the little water that flowed from the ground.

The wise man said to him:

That is what you will do to find God. Put aside your pride and recognize your need for God, the source of living water, kneeling to touch the ground. It is the only way to drink the water that would save you from dying of thirst. Likewise, to save your soul, you must recognize that without God you do not have salvation.

The Lord says that whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst, but the water that I give him will become a source of water for eternal life. (Jn 4, 14). And later he adds: *If anyone is thirsty, come to me, and drink whoever believes in me.* (Jn 7, 37b). And even more: *Those who are thirsty, who come near, and whoever wants, receive free water of life.* (Ap 22, 17c).

And now another little story, that of the professor who was invited to lecture at a military base, and at the airport he was received by a soldier named Ralph, who found God serving his fellows.

Picking up the bags, Ralph helped an old woman with her luggage, loaded two children to see Santa Claus, and helped a person, while smiling happily.

Where did you learn to behave like that? the professor asked.

In the war, Ralph answered. In Vietnam his mission had been to clear minefields, seeing as several friends met an untimely death.

I got used to living step by step. I never knew if the next one was going to be the last one, and that's why I had to make the most of the time between lifting a foot and supporting it again. Each step was a lifetime.

No one can know what will happen tomorrow. How sad would the world be if we knew it. All the excitement of living would be lost, and our life would be like a movie we've already seen. No surprise, no emotion. I think what is required is to see life as what it is, a great and exciting adventure.

And in that experience, Ralph observed that in the end it will not matter who has accumulated more wealth, nor who has gone further, but the only thing that will matter is whoever has loved the most.

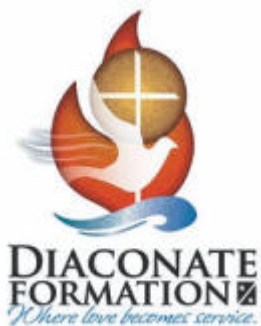
Ralph realized that the more he loves, the more he has served, because he appreciates his life and the lives of others, and as the Lord says, when referring to the poor, the elderly, the children, the needy and the helpless: *Truly I tell you, that whatever they do to one of these little brothers of mine, they did it to me.* (Mt 25, 40).

The rich and proud knelt and found God. Ralph found him serving his neighbor.
