Today Christ unmask a concern in many people of our time - believing that the sufferings of life have to do with friendship or enmity with God. When all goes well and there is no great anguish or despair, we believe that we are in peace and friendship with God. While it may be that we don't suffer great difficulties when we are close to God, Christ shows us that this is not always the case.

Do the thousands of people who die in attacks suffer in this way because they were more sinful than us? Of course not, because God is not an unjust legislator who punishes those who sin. Better to worry about our own conversion and stop judging others for what happens to them in life. What if our neighbor lost his business because he did not give alms or another was divided by divorce because he did not go to Mass or someone has a child die because he said blasphemies.

Let's stop calculating how others are before God and be more interested in our own conversion. The painful events of life are not the key to seeing God's relationship with our neighbor. God can allow a lot of suffering in a family to grow in faith and trust with Him, but that does not mean that God is against them.

Purpose - Let us direct our lives to God and be more concerned about our own conversion.

Dialogue with Christ - There are no excuses, the lesson of the parable is clear. When the Creator comes to seek fruit, it is because it is time to bear fruit. It is not about pretending or looking good, but having produced the fruits according to God's plan. Thank you, Jesus, for interceding for me and giving me another opportunity so that, with the grace of the Eucharist, I can rectify what must change in my life and aspire to apostolic effectiveness, where it is necessary to die to my own comfort in order to bear fruit.
