Gospel Reflections

One of the characteristics of Christ's love is that it has no limits. He loved with his words, with his hands, with his gestures, with his attitudes. On that afternoon, Jesus loved his people as no one had ever loved them before. He loved them to the limit, to the end, until he gave his life. Jesus demonstrated this love to others in service and in being attentive in small things.

Jesus was a special man, extraordinary in generosity. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. (Acts 10:38). That is why Paul advised Christian followers: "Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus" (Heb 12: 2), to feel and act like him. He was sent to announce the Good News to the poor, to proclaim the release of captives, to give sight to the blind, to give freedom to the oppressed and to proclaim the year of the Lord's grace (Lk 4,18-19). He came to "seek and to save what was lost." (Lk 19:10).

Jesus was a good man, with a deep-seated kindness, reflecting the essential values. His radical kindness was in "listening" to the needs of others. He completely dedicated his life for all. He did not come to be served but to serve and give his life as a ransom for all (Mk 10,45). He never condemned anyone, he tried to save everyone, to give life and to be a source of living water. The whole life of Jesus was in service to the Father and was given as the price of our liberation. "You will love God with all your heart and all your soul," finds its new fullness in the word and life of Jesus. God, for him, is the only good (Mk 10,18), the loving Father (Mt 5, 45) who seeks the lost sheep (Lc 15,4-7), because he is a God who seeks and welcomes those who were lost (Lc 15.2).
