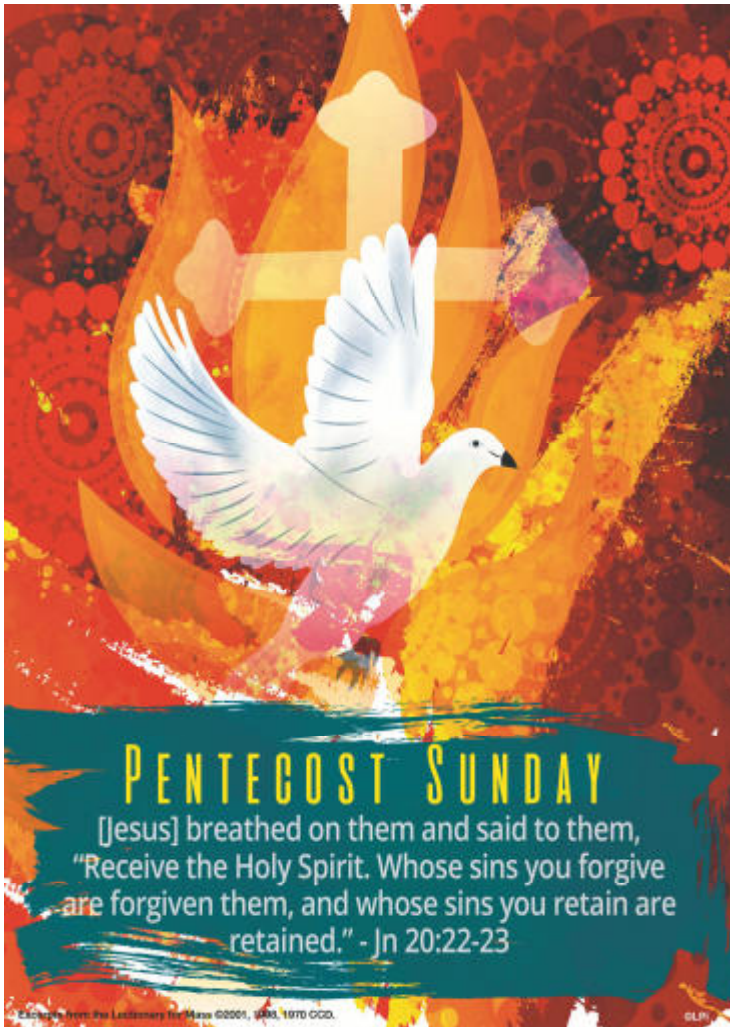

At Last Years' Pentecost at Fox Lake Correctional, we set a goal of growing how many people came to the mass, we had 20 at that mass. We asked for the assistance of the Holy Spirit and the guys went out, according to their abilities and language, and invited others to participate. At each liturgy we all participated with energy and kept focused and free of destructive drama (which keeps people away from church). The results of this is that at last week's Ascension Mass we had 28 guys.



Our parishes last year set three goals and asked for the assistance of the Holy Spirit

1. Build up family ministry which we did through additional offerings one of which is happening this summer through a re-worked Vacation Bible School designed for families July 28 to August 1. The new camp-like setting will be at a variety of times and locations with lots of hands-on activities for the whole family (per your responses to our surveys.)
2. Eucharistic Adoration was set as a goal and four longer events were scheduled. Three have already been completed with 100's of people attending. Our fourth event will be Friday, July 12, 5:30 p.m. to July 13 at 5:30 p.m. at St. John in Clyman.
3. Food for Souls has gotten kicked off with a garden started at St. John as an effort for all four parishes. We will have work details during Catholic Families Week and other occasions to garden, can, and give away food as a gift to our communities.

With all of these accomplishments since last Pentecost, the only question before us is what does the Holy Spirit want from us this year? We know we are remodeling and moving into St. Katharine Drexel Parish. We are finishing strategic planning for the tri-parishes. What more does the Holy Spirit want from us?
