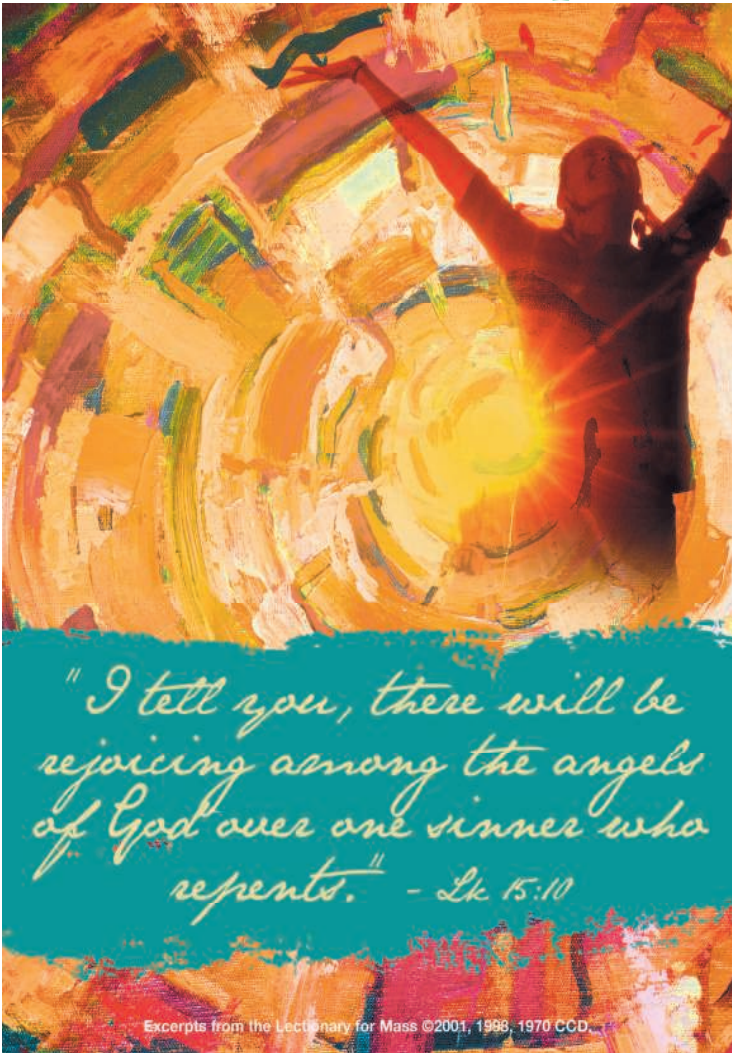

## Gospel Reflections... OUR LADY OF SORROW SEPTEMBER 15

The Gospels show the Blessed Virgin present, with immense love and pain of a Mother, next to the cross at the time of the redeeming death of her Son, joining her sufferings and deserving therefore the title of Co-redeemer.

The pictorial and iconographic representation of the Sorrowful Virgin moves the hearts of believers to justify the value of redemption and to better discover the malice of sin.

Under the title of the Virgin of Solitude or of Dolores, Mary is venerated in many places.

The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is celebrated on September 15 and we remember in it the sufferings that Mary went through throughout her life, for having accepted to be the Mother of the Savior.

This day accompanies Mary in her experience of a very deep pain, the pain of a mother who sees her beloved son misunderstood, accused, abandoned by fearful apostles, scourged by Roman soldiers, crowned with thorns, spit, slapped, walking barefoot under a splintering and very heavy wood towards Mount Calvary, where she finally witnessed the agony of his death on a cross, nailed to the feet and hands.

Mary draws her strength from prayer and confidence that God's Will is the best for us, even if we don't understand it.

It is She who, with her company, her strength and her faith, gives us strength in times of pain, in daily sufferings. Let us ask for the grace to suffer together with Jesus Christ, in our hearts, in order to unite the sacrifices of our lives to those of Her and understand that, in pain, we are more like Christ and we are able to love him more intensely.

The image of the Sorrowful Virgin teaches us to have strength in the face of life's sufferings. Let us find in it a company and a force to make sense of the sufferings themselves.

Some will tell you that God is not good because it allows pain and suffering in people. Human suffering is part of the nature of man, it is something inevitable in life, and Jesus has taught us, with his own suffering, that pain has the value of salvation. The important thing is the sense that we give.

We must be strong in the face of pain and offer it to God for the salvation of souls. In this way we can turn suffering into sacrifice (sacrum-facere = doing something sacred). This will help us to love God more and, in addition, we will take many souls to Heaven, joining our sacrifice to that of Christ.
