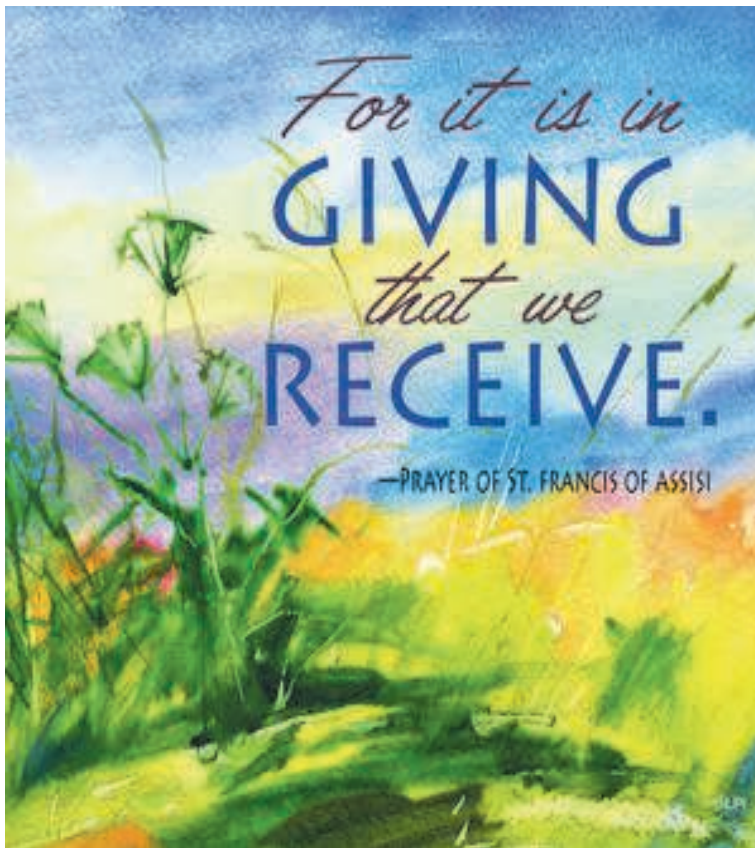

Gospel Reflections... My Why

Usually we start our stewardship conversation about what is church, and the jobs we need to get fulfilled to be a model church.

This year we wish to start with the big why that is inside each of us. The author Simon Sinek names that the most effective sequence to life is first to ask WHY, then ask HOW, and then finally ask WHAT. This sequence allows us to live and work with passion which will pull out the God given passion in others. If we all work with the call that is in each of us, the important functions of the church will be accomplished.

So let's think this through:

- Who have I been? What have been my areas of focus – they tell me about myself.
- With whom do I enjoy spending time? Do I enjoy spending time with God?
- What past behavior isn't really me?
- What is God calling out of me even if it is currently as small as a mustard seed?

Sometimes the best way of getting to my why is to think about big things I do or that stir emotions in me and ask "why" six times (in layers).

Without naming your name, write down your big why and add it to the collection after communion at the Tri-parishes October 5 and 6 and St. Katharine Drexel October 12 and 13. *Fr. Mike Erwin*
