Marriage: Active parishioners are to contact Fr. Mike Erwin at his Beaver Dam Office at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of the wedding. Couples must attend an Enrichment Day for the Engaged, and submit to a Pre-Marital Inventory.

Gospel Reflections... Come, Holy Spirit, Come

These words take on special meaning this year as we are trying to find our way through a pandemic in a life-saving creative way without destroying our economy.

And so far, believe it or not, it has worked. 80% of the people are still employed and we have saved well over 100,000 people.

But we are not done yet. We still want to find creative ways to worship, work, and take care of each other while getting even better at being safe. One way we are doing this is starting up contact people to call if you are feeling anxious or need another person to process your losses and fears. We also continue to learn. Recently we had a very constructive Chamber of Commerce meeting in Beaver Dam

where leaders of the Richelieu plant were sharing lessons they learned in their number of cases. They should be commended for their humility and openness; some people will pick on them for having problems but they should be commended for their transparency. They also pushed repeatedly the importance of masks which are very effective even if only one person is wearing it.

But why won't we wear masks? Does it show we are afraid and don't want to be teased for being afraid? The more we are filled with the Holy Spirit, the less afraid we are and the more inner peace we have which makes us immune to the mockery of others.

We will continue to stream masses so you do not have to take unnecessary risks for your health situation. Who knows if Fr. Erick and I will always be available – if we get sick from anything like COVID 19 we will need to isolate as well. But it will all be ok. When the apostle Paul got jailed he simply prayed more knowing he would be ok through torment, or isolation, or freedom, or death.

We have scheduled the dedication of St. Katharine Drexel church for Sunday, June 14 at 11 a.m. We will not be able to have everybody present for the liturgy but will again stream it. After mass, from 1:30 until 6 p.m. we will have the church, through the new entrance, open to receive communion from that mass and to look around with very few people present.

Plans for Resuming Sunday Mass for the Tri-parishes

1. When: starting Pentecost Weekend – May 30 and 31.

St. Columbkille at 5:00 p.m. Saturday, 65 Person Capacity

Holy Family Parish at 8:00 a.m. Sunday, 50 Person Capacity

St. John the Baptist Parish at 10:00 a.m. Sunday, 65 Person Capacity

2. What: a simple form of the mass of the day.

3. Who: we ask that we keep this to current or potential members of the tri-parishes. If you are sick in any way please stay home or if you have a health condition that makes you susceptible to such a serious respiratory flu.

The Archbishop asks us to limit attendance to 25% of the church's capacity (see above); if we have too many people at any mass we will need volunteers to leave and be assured a spot at the next mass.

Both Ss. John and Columbkille have hearing only seating in the lower levels.

4. Where: We will use every other pew and start filling from opposite ends (right/left) to maximize distance between people.

5. Cleaning: the plan is to close doors after mass and space will be free of possible virus in 4 days. If we need the space more frequently for a funeral or adoration, we will clean as necessary with dawn dish soap water.

6. For communion distribution we will release one pew at a time with 6 feet of room between each family.

7. There will be no choir. We are allowed one keyboard player and one cantor per mass with minimal congregational singing.
