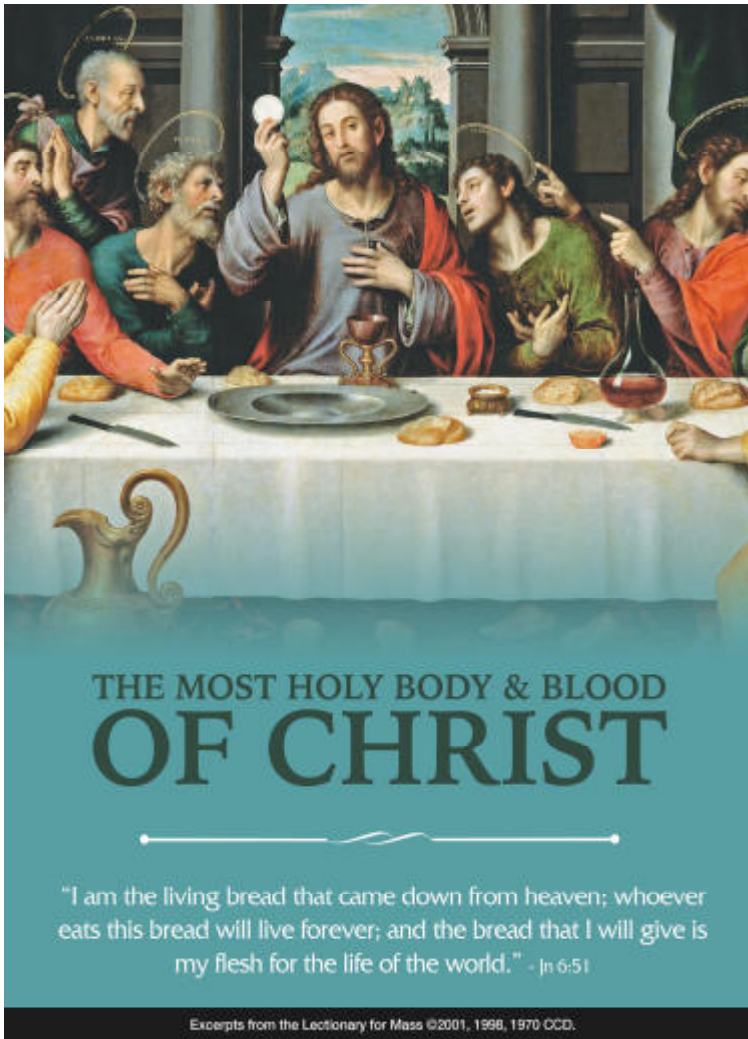

Gospel Reflections... Sing a New Church Into Being

When Jesus first prayed the words of institution “this is my body, this is my blood” he probably wasn’t singing. With the gift of hindsight, though, the apostles could have heard the song in it. Music makes expressing emotions so much easier especially the grief, joy, hope, promise, sacrifice and many other emotions found in the Eucharistic prayer. The reconciliation offered to a broken community to find healing and wholeness gives us an impulse to rejoice.

This weekend, on the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ we are dedicating the renovated church building at St. Katharine Drexel Parish. We will be rejoicing over the design, construction and decorating to be sure. We will rejoice that God is getting us through this pandemic. We will rejoice that God is purifying us through this social unrest to more clearly see him in all of his children. We will rejoice that this great merger of the three parishes of Beaver Dam into one is completed in a church building made new for all.

The dedication has many parts:


1. The handing over of the church to the bishop.
2. The proclamation of scripture and preaching.
3. The consecration of the altar and walls with Chrism.
4. The incensing of the church for the first time.
5. The entrance of lit candles.
6. And most importantly, the offering of Eucharist for the first time on this new altar.

The new altar was designed after the architecture of the St. Katharine Drexel Mother House. A lot of the rest of the church contains sacred art from our three previous parishes; but along with the altar the round pews are new to all and not only focus us toward the altar but unite us into one community. The baptismal font, in the center of the church celebrates our common reconciliation in Christ. The new gathering area will be used to build holy and service oriented friendships. The Eucharistic chapel will give us space to listen to the song.

I am sorry we cannot have more people in church during this pandemic, but I have invited 120 people who represent a wide variety of the parish to be present. Please watch the Mass online if you are able, then come and make a visit to the church from 1:30 to 6:00 p.m. to see the church and pray there and receive the Body of Christ.

We all have many different emotions right now but we find it all in the song of Jesus’ Eucharistic Prayer which dedicates the church building, speaks to our souls, and unites us together as the Body of Christ. Blessings and Love,
