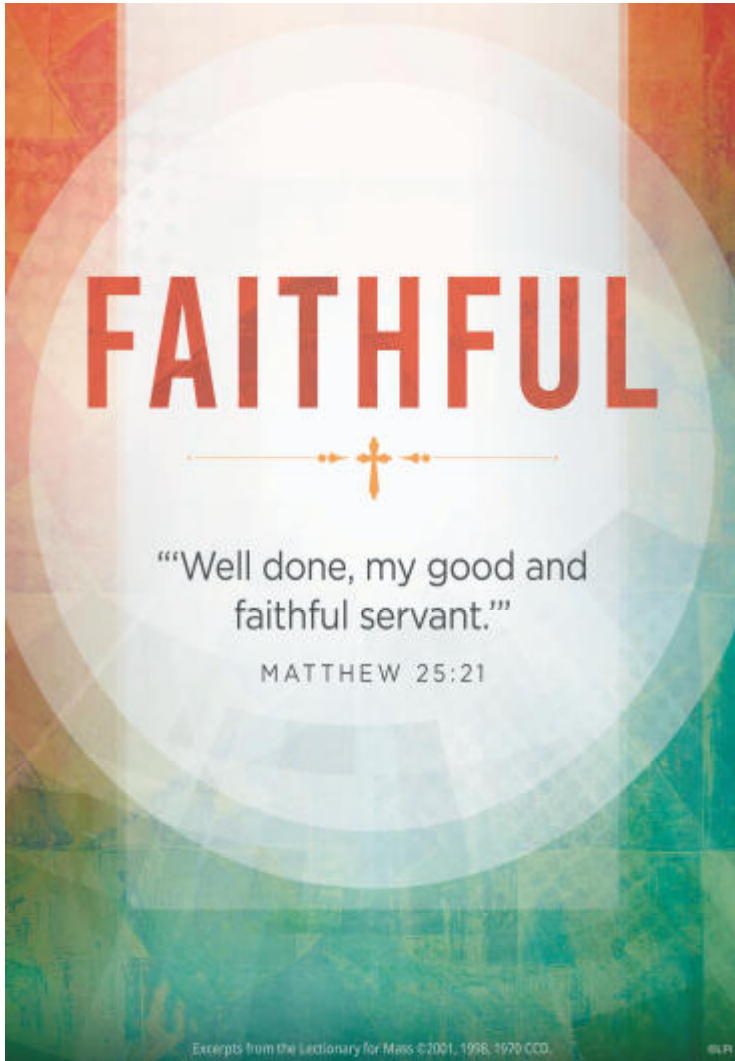

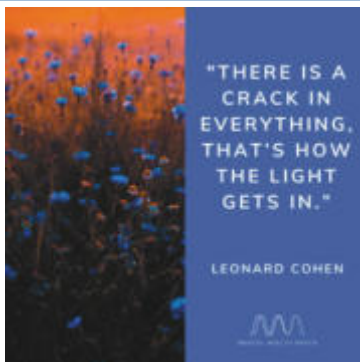
Of course real construction people, seeing me start this project, came running in very concerned. But that only garnered me more workers, who actually knew what they were doing.
