Gospel Reflections... Right to Life through Our Sacrifice

In today's second reading we understand that our bodies are very important as they are to be temples of the Holy Spirit. This week we consider this again as we consider the right to a living body until a natural death for all people from conception to natural death.

Amidst the chaos of the recent weeks in Washington D. C. a member from one of our parishes reminded me of substantial talk that Mother Teresa, now Saint, gave at the National Prayer Breakfast in Washington, D.C, on February 5, 1994. She named abortion as the great destroyer of peace in the world today. There are other issues she brings up as well but names this as the center piece.

Key to the talk is her solution to abortion which we need to talk about. She states abortion can be ended when we give until it hurts so as to communicate: "I want your child". She goes on to also share many stories about people also dying of hunger or loneliness in old age, showing that it is interconnected as all of these need us to give until it hurts so as to communicate real love.

Mother Teresa's efforts and those of others have helped make abortion increasingly unpopular and an option more women would never choose. Because of this, the Supreme Court will probably in 2021 make decisions to end or greatly curtail abortion. If we wish for this pro-life position to stay the law of the land, these children and their mothers and fathers, will need to know that we want their child and we are willing to give until it hurts to make that happen. This might mean we have to pay more taxes for health care, education, counseling, nutrition and shelter so that our pro-life success will be sustainable.

This takes us back to this weekend's scripture. Our bodies, filled with the Holy Spirit, can be put to tireless work, like Mother Teresa, to help children, parents, injured and seniors. We are baptized into the Lamb of God who gave his life so others could live. Filled with the Holy Spirit, let us be a church and a country that gives everything that others can live.

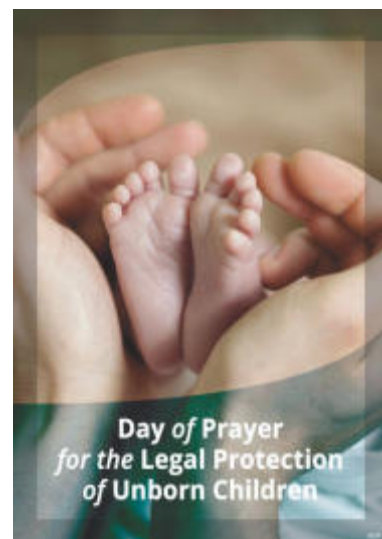
