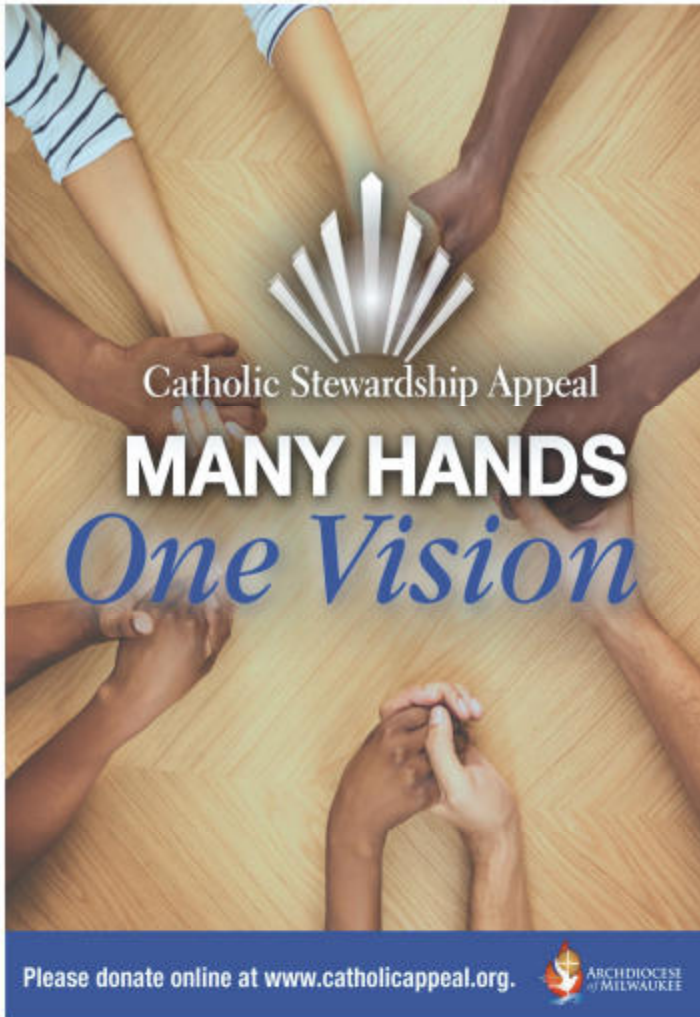

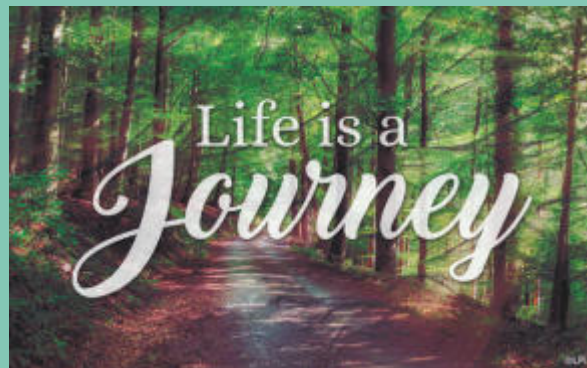

## *Gospel Reflections...* What does “ordinary time” mean?

Ordinary Time of the Liturgical year started on Monday, January 11. Many people wonder why we call this time “ordinary.”

We need to remember that Christmas and Easter are the main feasts of our Christian faith and they are highlighted by the Church. The rest of the year, about 34 Sundays, is called “Ordinary Time.”



We have two periods for which we use the term “ordinary time”: after the season of Advent-Christmas-Epiphany, and after the time of Lent-Easter-Pentecost.

The season of Ordinary Time is divided into two parts. The first part of Ordinary Time begins on January 11, 2021 and ends on February 16, 2021. The second part begins on May 24, 2021 and ends on November 27, 2021

The term Ordinary here means "numbered," "counted," "ordered." So “Ordinary Time” is called “ordinary” because the weeks are numbered. The Latin word ordinalis, which refers to numbers in a series, comes from the Latin ordo, from which we get the English word order. “Ordinary” does not mean "common," "plain" or "mundane."

Appropriately the priest wears green vestments during Ordinary time, and also the sanctuary is decorated with the same color.

I hope this explanation has been helpful for your liturgical understanding of Ordinary Time, which we can see is not so ordinary time.
