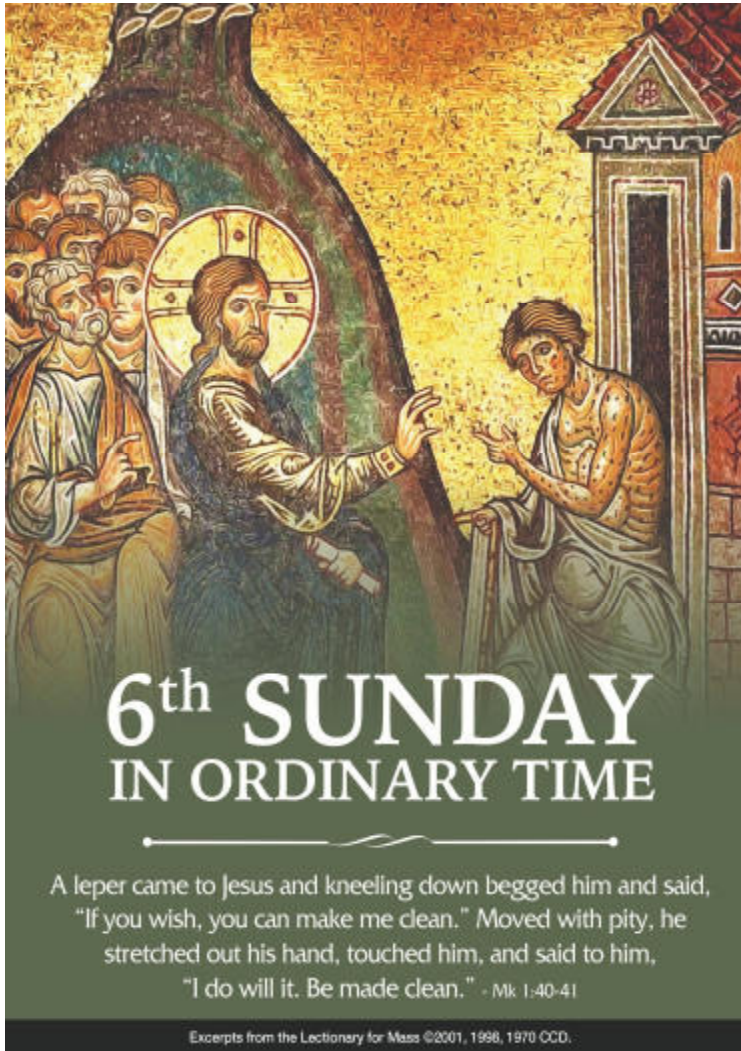

Gospel Reflections... Jesus Enters into our Messiness

Last weekend we had the Archdiocesan Stewardship Appeal. If you have not seen the beautiful video they issued this year, you are strongly encouraged to view it. A key part to the archbishop's message was to thank everyone, including you, for keeping the faith during COVID. When we keep the faith when facing adversity, it is a greater sign of the reality and power of God working through us.

Early in the pandemic we made a special effort to thank front line workers such as EMT's, nurses, doctors, and the like. They have been taking the greater risk to get inside of the social bubbles of people, including sick people, to care for them. Now as we get our vaccine shots let us remember to thank these medical and clerical workers who are also taking a risk to administer the vaccines.

In this week's readings Jesus does the same with infectious people of his time: lepers. Their disease had grave symptoms and they were very infectious. In spite of this, Jesus showed his commitment to all of us by getting so close to this dangerous situation to care for people who needed it.

Jesus still does that with us. If we have some aspect of ourselves that needs attention but we are afraid to talk about with the world; know that Jesus Christ is available to us directly in prayer and through the healing sacraments of reconciliation and anointing. These are confidential moments in which we can share our challenges with the Lord.
