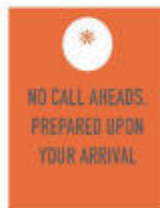

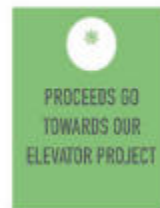

Gospel Reflections... Those who do evil things do not love the light

There are many reasons to love the church. It is a great community to belong to. For many of us there is a long family history. We have wonderful Catholic school systems and faith formation for the next generation.

So like the leaders of the temple that Jesus confronted in last week's Gospel; it is possible to belong and even be a leader of a church and still harbor a darkness that we are unwilling to hand over to the light of Christ. Twelve step programs discovered this many years ago as they emphasized spirituality as an important component of recovery. Often the people who are very involved in church have the hardest time as they have developed a habit of keeping this one area of their life away from the grace of Christ.

We are in the hard hitting part of Lent this weekend when it is important for us to identify the true weakness that we have and to bring this to Christ. We do not need to focus our attention on other people's sins - then we are simply avoiding our own sins. Now we need to come back into ourselves and do some courageous and honest searching for our sins. We have opportunities for reconciliation every Saturday morning at the St. Katharine Drexel Parish center from 9:30 to 10:30 and Thursdays from 6 to 7 during adoration at St. Columbkille. March 17th from 6:15 - 7:30 at Holy Family Church, Fr. Mike & Fr. Sergio will be available to hear confessions. On March 24 we are having a special opportunity from 1 to 7 p.m. at the SKD parish center with priests from throughout our two counties. This allows us to acknowledge the things we would really rather keep to ourselves, to a prayerful priest who is forbidden to share this with anyone else. Here Jesus is able to provide forgiveness through this healing Sacrament.

Nicodemus came at night hoping to avoid notice for speaking to Jesus Christ or of really believing. Jesus challenges him that only wicked people who want to stay wicked avoid the light. Let us truly trust the light of Christ into all aspects of ourselves, especially those parts we prefer to keep in the dark.
