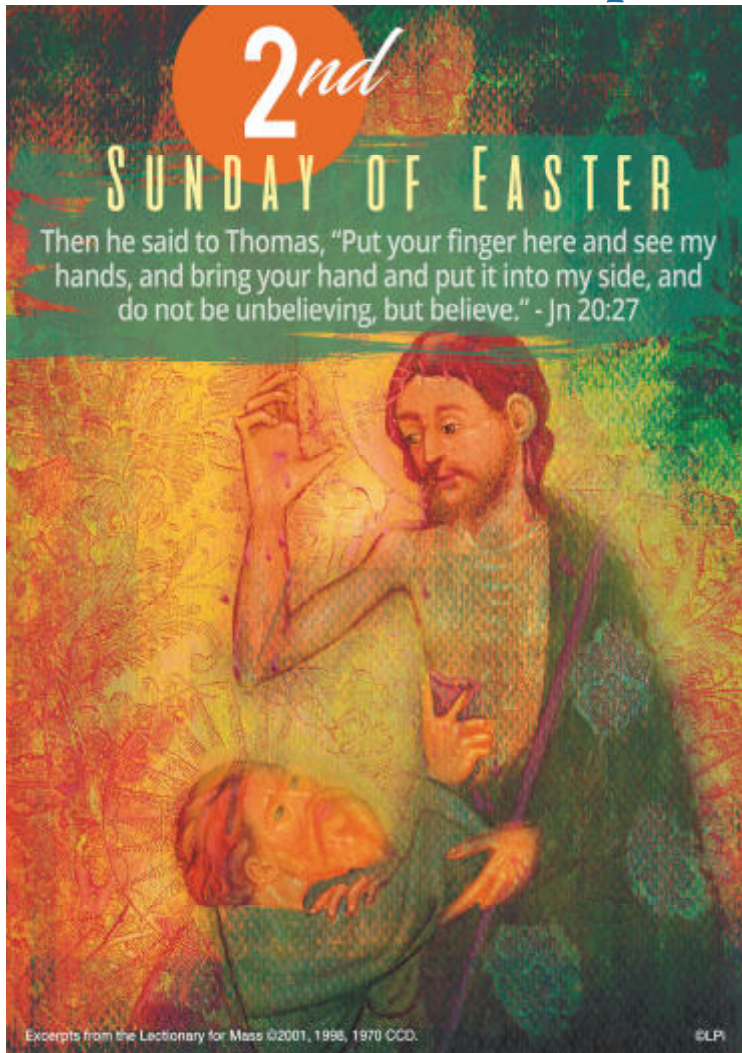

Gospel Reflections... Divine Mercy Sunday

When someone comes to me with a confession of something really big there is very often a sense that Jesus will not forgive this big thing.

This is when I remind people that Jesus didn't die on the cross because we steal pens and pencils (which is still wrong though). He died on the cross because we do some pretty major things more frequently than we know about each other.

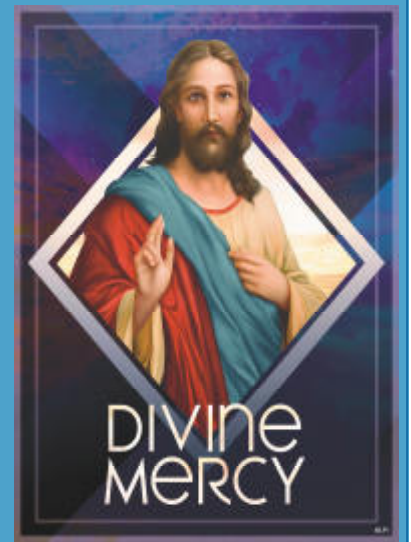
In the Gospels we hear especially about Peter who denied Jesus as he was going to the cross and Paul who was a party to murdering the first deacon.

These are some pretty major things to do wrong and yet they become two of the most important leaders in church history. They could turn their lives around by the mercy of Jesus Christ.

The center of today's Gospel is Thomas who is one of the last Apostles to believe in the resurrection. Jesus so desired him to say yes with his faith that he invited Thomas to touch his wounds from the nails and the soldier's lance.

Us priests continue to hear confessions during Easter Season and all year around at 6 p.m. on Thursdays at St. Columbkille, Elba and 9:30 a.m. at the parish center at St. Katharine Drexel. Divine Mercy Sunday which we celebrate this weekend, encourages us to receive the reality of the resurrection by turning over our sins to Jesus. We look forward to new life through the resurrection but it won't take off until we experience the forgiveness Jesus is offering us for what we have done in the past.
