When? How am I a witness to Jesus on earth?

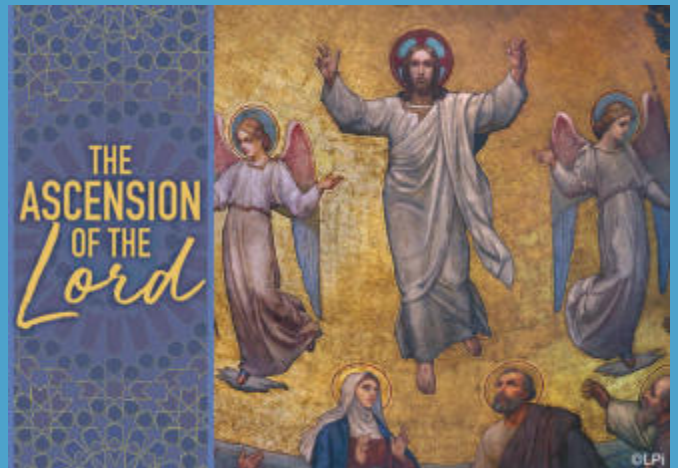
