## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

**ON RELICS:**

Catholics have always had a fascination with and veneration for relics. What is a relic - it is a physical object having to do with a saint.

**3 Classes of Relic:**

**1 - First Class** - is a body of a saint or part of a body of a saint. The bones of the saints and martyrs have been venerated since the earliest days of Christianity. Most Catholics altars contain a first relic class within or underneath. It may seem foreign to our sight but treasured highly.

**2 - Second Class** - it is articles of the saint's clothing or something that the saint touched and used often.

**3. Third Class** - are objects that have been touched to a first class relic. Example - rosary or holy card that was laid on a tomb of saint.

The vessel that holds the relic is called **reliquary**.

Relics give us a reminder of the holy person. It is not a lucky charm. They contain no magical powers. God uses relics to facilitate miracles.

In our Parish (Lena Site), we have the relic of POPE PIUS X (second class) in the sanctuary (altar). He is best remembered as Pope of the Eucharist. He said that Holy Communion is the shortest and surest way to heaven.
