FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This is one of the two miracles of healing Jesus performed for Gentiles. The other is the healing of the centurion's servant. These miracles foreshadow the future preaching of the gospel to the whole world. Jesus first ignored both the persistent cry of the woman and the impatience of his disciples who wanted to send the woman away. He then tried to awaken true faith in the heart of this woman by an indirect refusal. We notice that the woman was refused three times by Jesus before he granted her request and finally, the fourth time, her persistence was rewarded and her plea was answered. Jesus was completely won over by the depth of her faith, her confidence and her wit and hence responded exuberantly, "Woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish."

Lesson: We need to persist in prayer with trustful confidence.
