



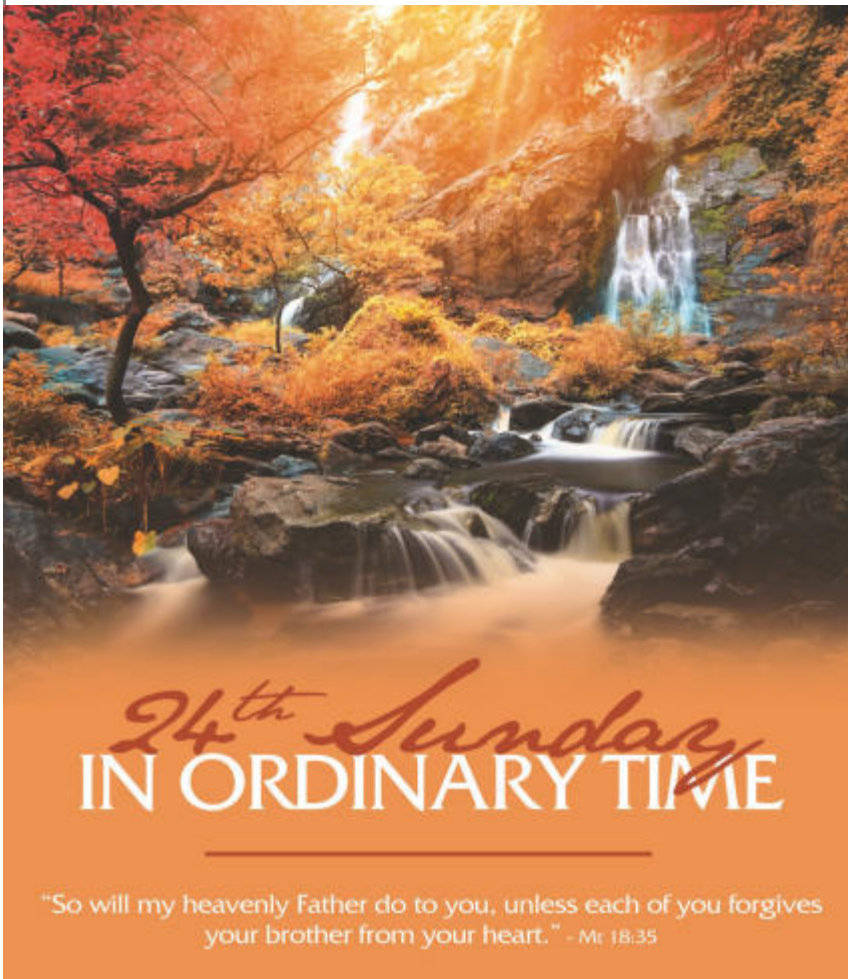

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The parable of two debtors is Jesus' answer to Peter's question, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" The gospel passage specifically emphasizes two ideas. The first idea is that there should be no limit to our forgiveness and no condition attached to our reconciliation. The second idea, found in the parable of two debtors, is that we should forgive our offenders mercifully and be reconciled with them.

Practical applications: We must forgive in order to be forgiven. Jesus explains this after teaching the prayer, "Our Father." "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father also will forgive you." In the light of eternity and the shortness of our span of life, harboring old grudges is pointless. We are represented as the greater debtor in the parable because we commit sins every day and, hence, need God's forgiveness every day. Let us remember St. Francis Assisi's prayer: "It is in pardoning that we are pardoned."
