



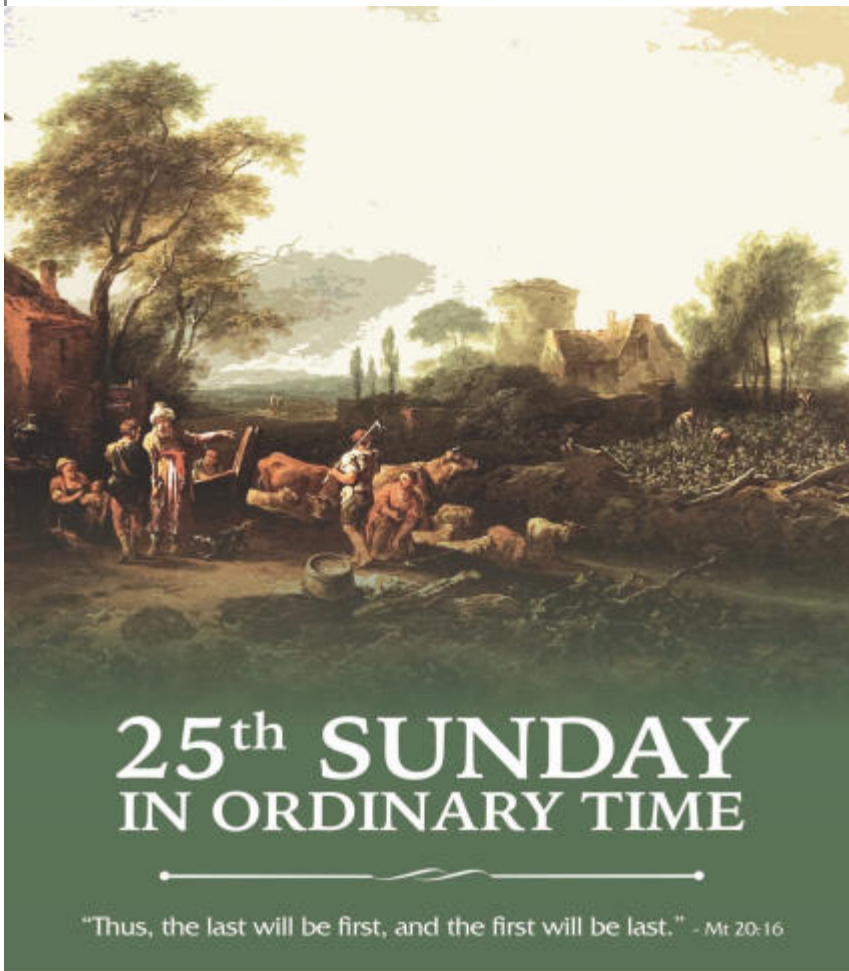

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The parable described in gospel this weekend (Sunday) is known as the "Parable of Workers in the Vineyard" or the "Parable of the Generous Landlord." There is good news in this parable because it is the story of the landlord's love and generosity, representing God's love and generosity. The question in God's mind is not "How much do these people deserve?" but rather, "How can I help them? How can I save them before they perish?" It's all about grace and blessings. Somehow, God is presented in the parable as a loving mother who cares about each of her children equally.

What each of the workers received was a symbol of the Love of God, who is the vineyard owner. All - early arrivals and latecomers - got exactly the same, the love of their Master and Lord. There are not various degrees of that love. It is always one hundred percent. God is Love.

STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY

We will not have Sign-Up Sunday this year because of the virus. If anyone is interested in any of the ministries or committees, they should call the parish office or contact someone on the Worship Committee.

ADORATION

We will be changing the Adoration schedule to again alternate between Lena and Coleman. Starting in October, Adoration will be on the First Wednesday, October 7th, in Coleman at 7:30am followed by Mass. In November, it will be in Lena the First Friday, November 6th at 7:30am followed by Mass.

REMEMBRANCE TREE

We will again have the Remembrance Tree for those that have passed in the past year from the parish. We will also have the Remembrance Book with the names of anyone you would like to remember that have passed. If you would like to have someone's name added to the book please call or email the office so we can add their names to the book.

ANOINTING MASS

On the weekend of October 24th and 25th, immediately following the Mass, Father will be doing an Anointing of the sick after the 6pm Mass in Coleman and the 10:30am Mass in Lena. This is open for anyone that feels they could use the anointing.

SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Following much careful consideration, the dispensation for Sunday Mass obligation has been lifted and beginning the weekend of Sept. 19 and 20, all Catholics will once again gather as a community of faith on Sundays. The lifting of the dispensation was announced in a decree issued by Bishop David Ricken on Monday, Sept. 7.

With this news, please note there are still occasions when the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply:

- If individual Catholics struggle with serious health concerns or are physically or morally prevented from worshipping at Mass for a grave reason
- If individuals are frail due to illness or age or, in their well-formed consciences believe that going into public places -- including Sunday worship at Mass -- would place their health or the health of their loved ones in serious jeopardy
- If individuals are sick, or have been in contact with someone who has been sick.

The faithful who are unable to attend Mass are urged to make holy the Lord's Day and to pray, read the Scriptures, watch a broadcast or livestreamed Mass and take part in acts of charity.

The obligation to attend Mass for Catholics reflects our faith in Jesus Christ, the blessing of the Holy Eucharist and an acknowledgment of His great love for us.

We are making accommodations at each site so that we can maintain social distancing while still welcoming everyone back to Mass. We also are cleaning the pews and chairs each Friday and then again after the last Mass each weekend. We will continue to provide updates as to how we are adjusting to the changes.

Items to include are small toys, coloring books, toothbrushes, hair clips, wash cloths, bar soap, socks, combs, jewelry, crayons, pencils, sharpeners, dolls, trucks, etc... The cost is \$9 per box to ship, so any donation to offset that cost would be greatly appreciated as well.
