



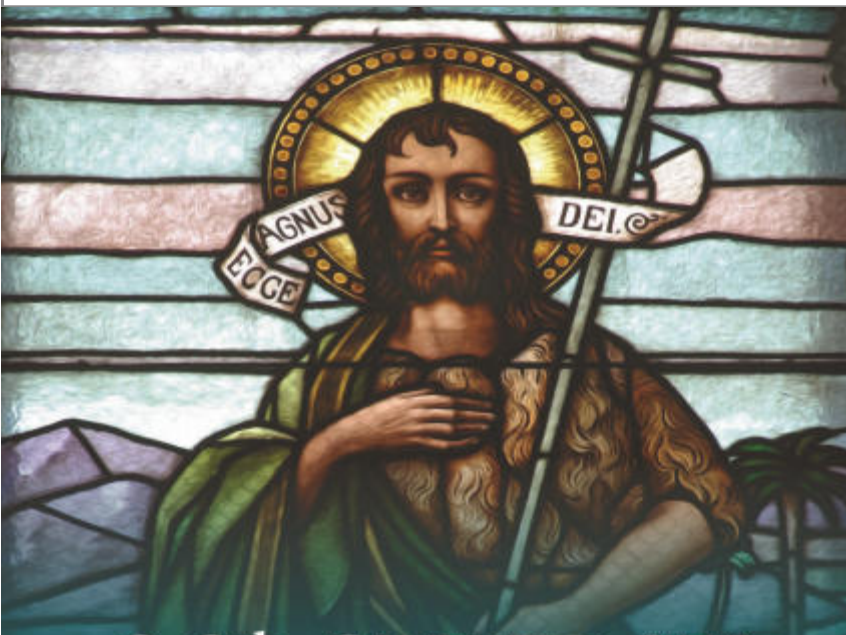

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

In the parable this weekend, a man who has two sons tells both to go out to work in the vineyard. The first says he will go but he does not. The second says he won't go, but later regrets his refusal and goes to work. The second son who first refused to go to work in the vineyard represents the tax collectors and sinners, while the first son who agreed to work but did not go represents the Scribes and the Pharisees. The parable gives us the warning that it is our final decision for or against God that is most important, because we are rewarded or punished according to it.

Jesus makes his point clear: Good intentions are not enough. Promises don't count unless they are performed. God wants to change our hearts so that we will show by our speech and by our actions that we respect His will and we are ready to do what He commands. God offers each of us the greatest treasure possible— unending peace, joy, happiness, and life with Him in His kingdom. We can lose that treasure if we refuse the grace God offers us to follow in His way of truth and righteousness.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, change my heart that I may truly desire that which is pleasing to you. Help me to respect your will and give me the strength, joy and perseverance to carry it out wholeheartedly.

### SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Following much careful consideration, the dispensation for Sunday Mass obligation has been lifted and beginning the weekend of Sept. 19 and 20, all Catholics will once again gather as a community of faith on Sundays. The lifting of the dispensation was announced in a decree issued by Bishop David Ricken on Monday, Sept. 7.

With this news, please note there are still occasions when the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply:

- If individual Catholics struggle with serious health concerns or are physically or morally prevented from worshipping at Mass for a grave reason
- If individuals are frail due to illness or age or, in their well-formed consciences believe that going into public places -- including Sunday worship at Mass -- would place their health or the health of their loved ones in serious jeopardy
- If individuals are sick, or have been in contact with someone who has been sick.

The faithful who are unable to attend Mass are urged to make holy the Lord's Day and to pray, read the Scriptures, watch a broadcast or livestreamed Mass and take part in acts of charity.

The obligation to attend Mass for Catholics reflects our faith in Jesus Christ, the blessing of the Holy Eucharist and an acknowledgment of His great love for us.

We are making accommodations at each site so that we can maintain social distancing while still welcoming everyone back to Mass. We also are cleaning the pews and chairs each Friday and then again after the last Mass each weekend. We will continue to provide updates as to how we are adjusting to the changes.

### SHINE

Items to include are small toys, coloring books, toothbrushes, hair clips, wash cloths, bar soap, socks, combs, jewelry, crayons, pencils, sharpeners, dolls, trucks, etc...
