



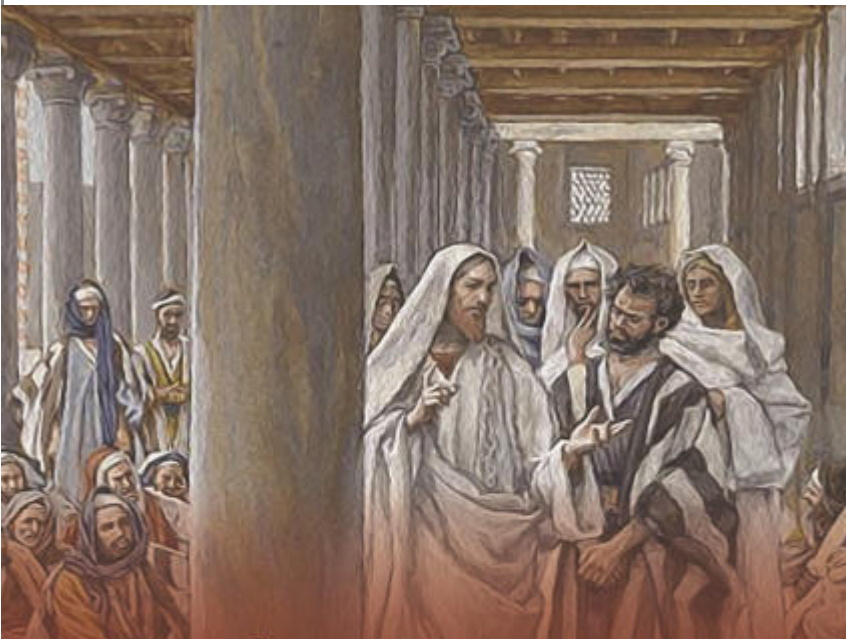

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Today's parable speaks about the punishment that will be given to the religious and political leaders of Israel. The text is highly allegoric. For example: The owner of the vineyard clearly represents God, while the vineyard stands for "the house of Israel." According to Matthew, the servants represent the prophets sent by God to Israel. The produce is the good works demanded by the Covenant relationship between God and the people. The "son" represents Jesus, to whose murder the vineyard owner responds by killing the tenants and leasing it to "other tenants." Those other tenants have been taken to mean the largely Gentile Church and the believing Jews.

For our personal reflection: God has called me to produce good fruits in his vineyard. In the aftermath of the many storms and hurricanes in life, how faithfully am I using my gifts to help others? Jesus said that whatever we do to the least of his brothers and sisters we do it to him; How is our society treating our suffering brothers and sisters especially this pandemic times?

SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Following much careful consideration, the dispensation for Sunday Mass obligation has been lifted and beginning the weekend of Sept. 19 and 20, all Catholics will once again gather as a community of faith on Sundays. The lifting of the dispensation was announced in a decree issued by Bishop David Ricken on Monday, Sept. 7.

With this news, please note there are still occasions when the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply:

- If individual Catholics struggle with serious health concerns or are physically or morally prevented from worshipping at Mass for a grave reason
- If individuals are frail due to illness or age or, in their well-formed consciences believe that going into public places -- including Sunday worship at Mass -- would place their health or the health of their loved ones in serious jeopardy
- If individuals are sick, or have been in contact with someone who has been sick.

The faithful who are unable to attend Mass are urged to make holy the Lord's Day and to pray, read the Scriptures, watch a broadcast or livestreamed Mass and take part in acts of charity.

The obligation to attend Mass for Catholics reflects our faith in Jesus Christ, the blessing of the Holy Eucharist and an acknowledgment of His great love for us.

We are making accommodations at each site so that we can maintain social distancing while still welcoming everyone back to Mass. We also are cleaning the pews and chairs each Friday and then again after the last Mass each weekend. We will continue to provide updates as to how we are adjusting to the changes.
