FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Jesus gave a straightforward answer, quoting directly from the Law itself and startling his listeners with his profound simplicity and mastery of the law of God and its purpose. Jesus combined the originally separate commandments and presented them as the essence of true religion.

Therefore, you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength. "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

How do we love God? There are several means by which we can express our love for God and gratitude to Him for His blessings, acknowledging our total dependence on Him. We must keep God's commandments, and offer daily prayers of thanksgiving, praise and petition. Meditate on His word in the Bible, and attend Mass and receive the Sacraments.

How do we love our neighbor? Since every human being is created in the "image and likeness of God," we are actually giving expression to our love of God by loving our neighbor as Jesus loves him. This means we have to help, support, encourage, forgive, and pray for every one of God's children without discrimination based on color, race, gender, age wealth or social status.

RE NEWS

All families should have received a phone call this week discussing important changes to our RE program.
