



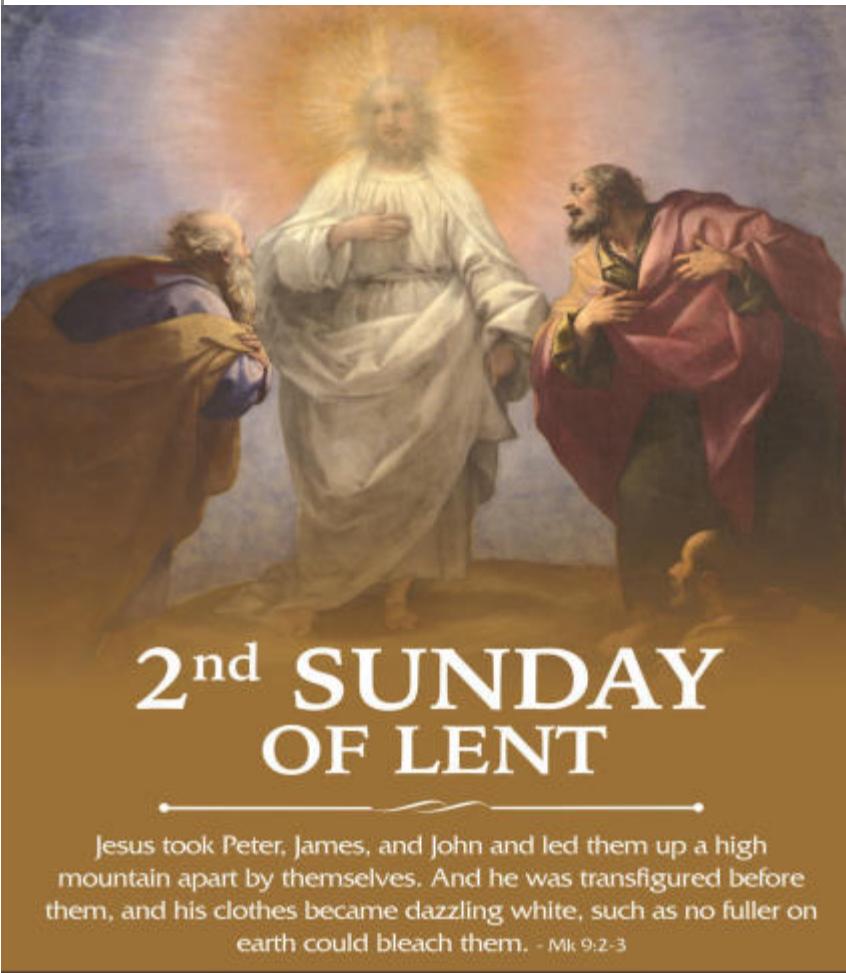

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Are you prepared to see God's glory? God is eager to share his glory with us! We get a glimpse of this when the disciples see Jesus transfigured on the mountain. Jesus' face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white.

In mass, there happens the substantial change of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ - we call this term as *Transubstantiation*. It is also the source of our transformation and strength. Our holy communion with Jesus in the Eucharist should be the source of our daily "transfiguration," - transforming our minds and hearts to do more good by humble and selfless service to others.

Each time we receive one of the sacraments, we are transformed: For example, baptism transforms us into sons and daughters of God and heirs of heaven. Confirmation transforms us into temples of the Holy Spirit and warriors of God. By the sacrament of reconciliation, God brings back the sinner to the path of holiness. Be transformed in Christ's name!

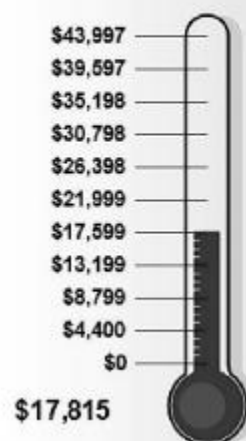
