



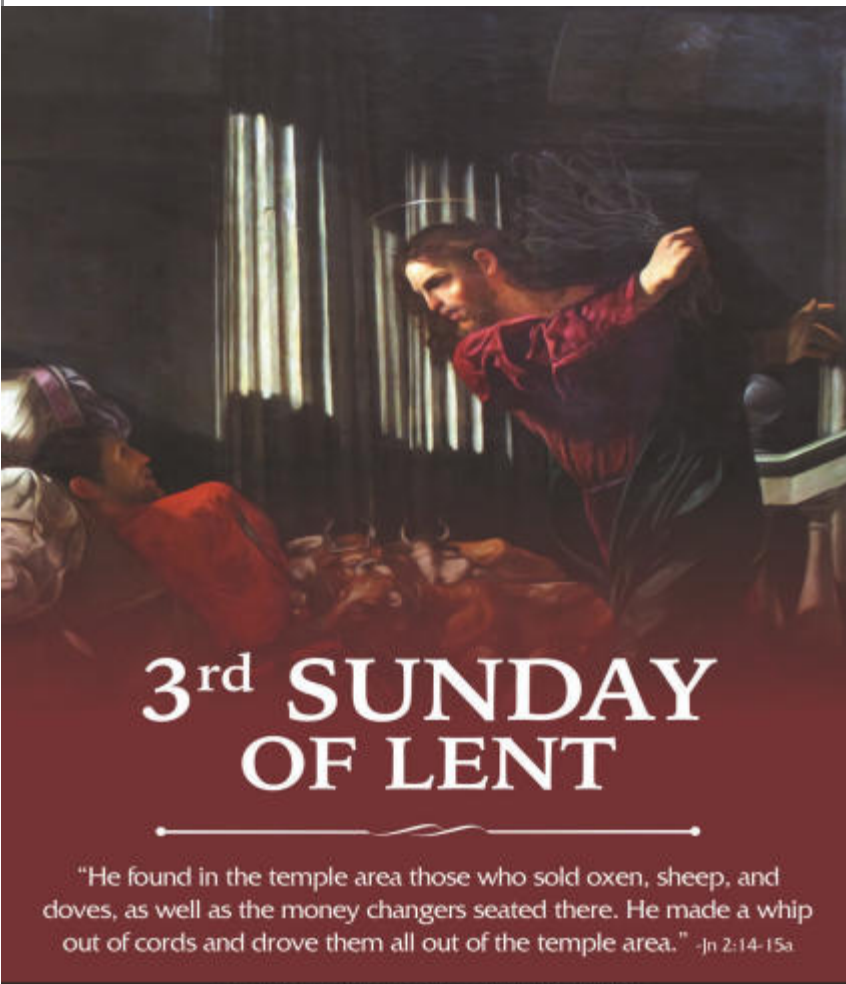

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Today's gospel gives us the dramatic account of Jesus' cleansing of the Temple in Jerusalem. The abuses which infuriated Jesus were - the conversion of a place of prayer to a noisy marketplace; the unjust business practices of animal merchants and money-changers, encouraged by the Temple authorities. Hence, Jesus made a whip of cords and drove away the animals and the money-changers. He said, "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace."

Lessons in life: We need to avoid the business mentality of loss and profit in divine worship. Our relationship with God must be that of a child to his parent, with no thought of loss or gain, but only mutual love, respect and desire for the common good. We need to remember that we are the temples of the Holy Spirit. Hence, we have no right to desecrate God's temple by impurity, injustice, pride, hatred or jealousy. We need to love our parish church and use it. Our church is the place where we come together as a community to praise and worship God, to thank Him for His blessings, to ask pardon and forgiveness for our sins and to offer our lives and petitions on the altar.

THE BURDEN OF DEBT

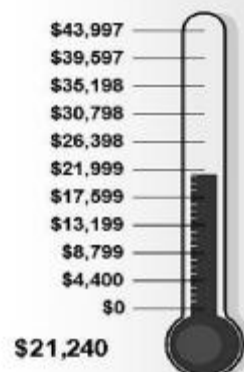
