FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Today, in the last part of Lent, the Church proposes this Gospel to help us attain Palm Sunday ready to live up to these mysteries so outstanding for our Christian life. The Way of the Cross becomes for us, Christians, a Way of Light, for dying is to be born again or, even better, we must die to this world so that we can live the Truth.

In the first part of this Gospel, Jesus tells the Apostles: Unless the grain of wheat falls to the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much fruit.

In this respect, St. Augustine comments: Jesus said He was "grain", that was to be mortified, to multiply afterwards; He was to be mortified by the infidelity of the Jews and He was to multiply for the faith of all the people. The bread of the Eucharist, made out of grains of wheat, is multiplied and divided to nourish all Christians. Let us make ourselves an spiritually nourished Christian in the Holy Eucharist.

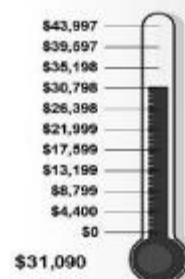
