



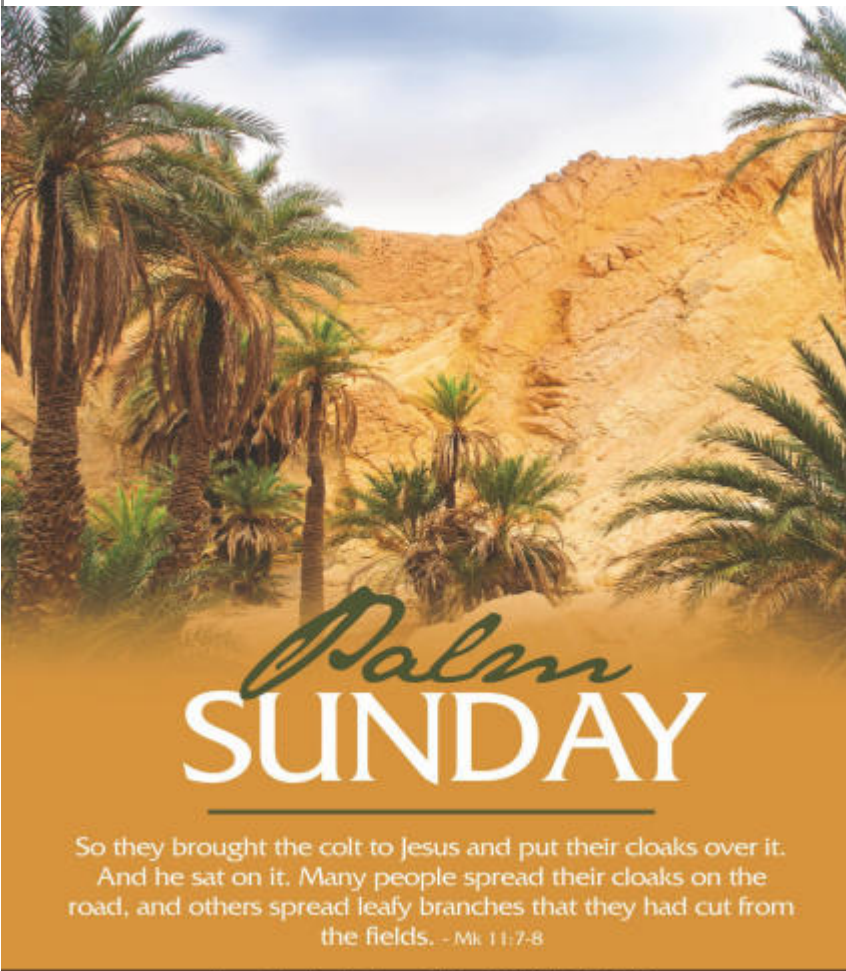

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This coming week, we remember and celebrate the day Jesus entered Jerusalem as Savior and King. As Jesus rode a donkey into the town of Jerusalem, a large crowd gathered and laid palm branches and their cloaks across the road, giving Jesus royal treatment. The hundreds of people shouted "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

The Gospel recounts what Jesus has done for us, is not then just some distant story. It is about what God has done for us; it is about our salvation and our life. We are not just passive spectators, or onlookers, or listeners: all that we recall on Palm Sunday (and during Holy Week and Easter of course) is about what Jesus has done for *us* and does for us right *now*. This is such a welcome message as we continue to try and do our best in the strange and difficult situation that we face at the moment.

Let us commemorate the Lord's entry into the city for our salvation, following in his footsteps, so that, being made by his grace partakers of the cross, we may have a share also in his Resurrection and in his life."

HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday: Palms will be blessed in front of the altar at the beginning of the mass. The faithful will pick up palms after mass upon departure.

Holy Thursday: Presentation of the oil (if the oil is ready) will be done at the beginning of the mass.

No washing of feet at Last supper this time

Good Friday: During veneration of the cross, only the deacon and the priest will kiss the cross/crucifix. The faithful will express reverence by gesture of genuflection or bow.

Easter Vigil Mass: Candles will not be used during the blessing of fire and renewal of baptismal promises.

WELCOMING NEW CATHOLICS

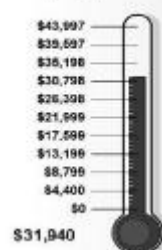
