



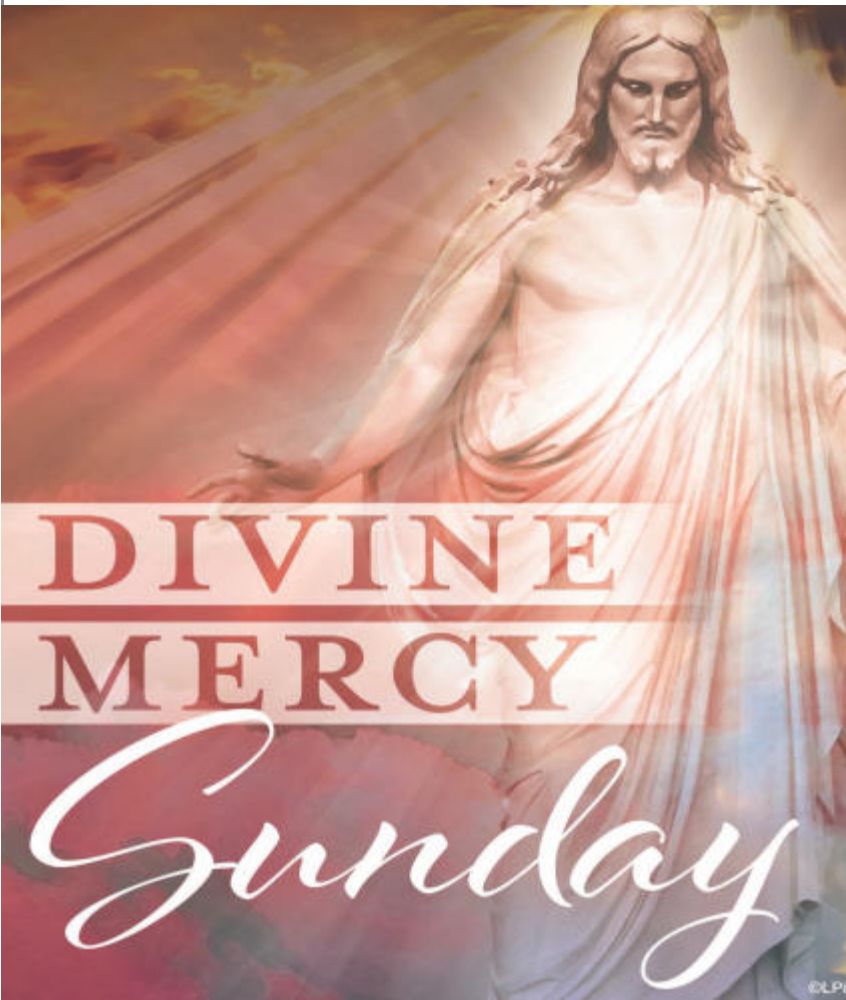

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This Sunday is the Feast of Divine Mercy - On October 5, 1938, a young religious by the name Sister Faustina (Helen Kowalska) died in a convent of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Cracow, Poland. She came from a very poor family that had struggled hard on their little farm during the terrible years of WWI.

The evening, when I was in my cell, I became aware of the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From the opening of the garment at the breast there came forth two large rays, one red and the other pale. In silence I gazed intently at the Lord; my soul was overwhelmed with fear, but also with great joy. After a while Jesus said to me, **'paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You.'** (Diary 47)* Some time later, Our Lord again spoke to her:

"The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous; the red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls...These two rays issued forth from the depths of My most tender Mercy at that time when My agonizing Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross...." (Diary 299)

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Fr. Celestine, Holy Family Parish, 2715 Taylor Street, Marinette, WI 54143, will be celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday with confessions at 2:00 and Mass at 3:00.

November 5, 1934, Jesus told Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska that He wanted the Divine Mercy image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and He wants it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. These words are taken from St Faustina's Diary (341) This is a very special Feast Day and many do not even know about it.

The Devotion to the DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET requires of us to go to confession during the novena that is, within the nine days before or after Easter. Celebrating the Divine Mercy Feast assures us of going to heaven if after that you remain in a state of grace without further committing mortal sins.

PLANTING SEEDS OF FAITH AT CAMP TEKAKWITHA

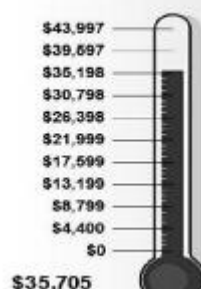
