FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Jesus uses His favorite image of the vine and the branches during His Last Supper discourse to help His disciples understand the closeness of their relationship with Him and the necessity of their maintaining it. This gospel passage also emphasizes the need for Christians to abide in Christ as an essential condition for producing fruits of kindness, mercy, justice, charity and holiness.

Now, He emphasizes that anyone who is separated from Him is good for nothing, like a branch separated from the vine. The fruitfulness of our apostolate/mission depends on living our union with Christ; as the Lord Himself said: He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

CEMETERY REGULATIONS

St. John, St. Leo & St. Wenceslaus Cemeteries: All decorations, flowers & containers must be removed by May 1st. Decorations may be replaced the Saturday before Mother's Day. Please limit one small compact item (two maximum) per monument. This can be put on either end of the monument or on the headstone. Flowers must be put in a container. No wire tripods are permitted. Thank you.

St. Charles & Sacred Heart Cemeteries: Open from dusk to dawn. Decorations may be placed between May 1st-September 30th. All decorations must be in a moveable urn or planter. A maximum of two urns per lot is permitted. No wire tripods, bird feeders or bird houses and only two Shepard hooks per grave. Vigil lights (two per grave) & veteran markers are permitted. Thank you.

CEMETERY FUND ENVELOPES

On behalf of the Cemetery Sextons, and our Parish leaders, we are calling your attention to, and asking for your generous support of our Cemeteries this year. You will find an envelope in the May bulletin for this purpose. Our parish remains responsible for five cemeteries. Because all of our cemeteries fall under WI State regulations, there are specific rules about where the money to support the perpetual care of these sites can come from. We are asking you to prayerfully consider the significant needs of two of these cemeteries, Sacred Heart and St. Wenceslaus, in great need. Your generous support, particularly in a troubled time, continues to be a great strength in our parish.

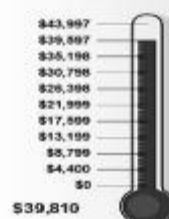
