




O God,

Pastor Father Bill's Weekly Column

Dear Parish Family:

This weekend we celebrate two great feasts — first, the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God, then the Epiphany of the Lord. In the first place, it is fitting that shortly after we observe the feast of Christmas, we should honor the Virgin Mother of the Lord.

In some ways, Our Lady is the protagonist of the Christmas story. It is she who plays an active role in welcoming the Son of God into the world. Her faith and her obedience to the will of God is the catalyst of our salvation. In giving human life to the Word of God, she readies the way for Christ to begin His saving work.

Next, this Sunday we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. The word epiphany means "manifestation" or "revelation". On this day, we commemorate the arrival of the Magi from the East, through whom the Lord reveals himself not only to the Jews, but to the Gentiles as well. In essence, this feast day is an acknowledgment that Christ the Lord comes to be the Savior of the whole human race.

The gifts of the Magi presented to the child Jesus are symbolic of His Divine identity and mission. Gold fit for a king, for He is the King and Lord of all. Incense offered in prayer, because through Him all our prayers are presented before the Father in Heaven. Myrrh, an oil used to anoint a body after death, because, born to die, He will give new life to the world.


