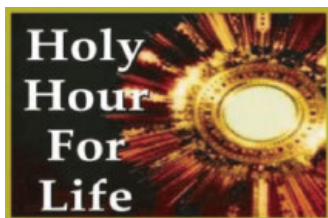

It Takes All Kinds

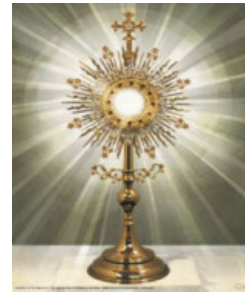
