Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

Catholics in good health between the ages of 18 & 59 are required to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of having only one meal with the possibility of two small snacks that do not total a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent.

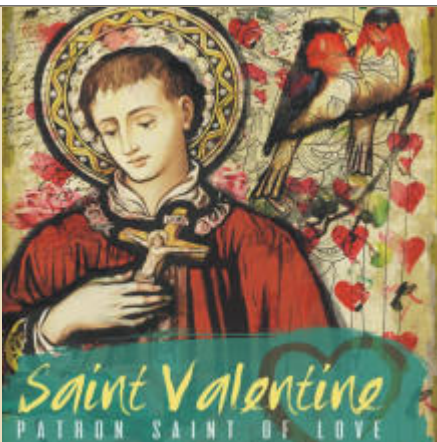

Sacraments

Baptism

Parents seeking baptism for their child must come to the parish office to register for a baptism prep. class and provide their child's birth certificate. Deacon Bill Stankevitz holds a classes on the 3rd Sunday of each month following the 10:00 a.m. Mass.

Marriage

Couples should contact the office six months prior to their proposed wedding date.

Anointing of the Sick

This is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. The sacrament should be sought as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age.

"Is any among you sick? Let him call for the priests of the Church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven."

Contact the office if you or a loved one would like to receive the sacrament of anointing.

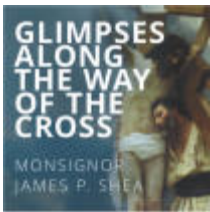

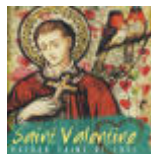
