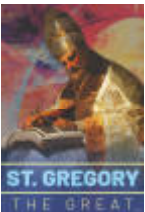

Anointing of the Sick and Viaticum Sacraments for the Living

Anointing of the sick is to be celebrated at the beginning of one's illness, who wishes for God's grace throughout their physical or psychological illness.

Viaticum, often referred to as "Last Rites" is celebrated when a person is still conscious. The family should call a priest while their loved one is still living, not after death. In cases of someone who suddenly becomes unconscious, the sacrament is administered, assuming the individual would want to receive it.

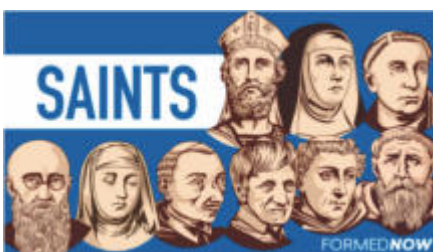

La unción de los enfermos debe celebrarse al comienzo de la enfermedad de quien desea la gracia de Dios a lo largo de su enfermedad física o psicológica.

El viático, a menudo denominado "Últimos ritos", se celebra cuando una persona aún está consciente. La familia debe llamar a un sacerdote mientras su amado aún viva, no después de la muerte.
