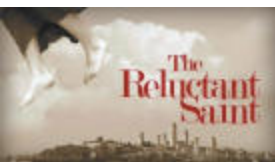
### Saint Catherine of Genoa

The feast day of our Parish's patroness is coming up! On September 15th, we will be celebrating the date of her birth in Heaven. With that comes a plenary indulgence for those who have a spirit detached from sin and meet these three conditions.

1. Receive Holy Communion on that day
2. Go to confession within two weeks of that date (before or after)
3. Say Prayer intentions for Pope Francis (One our Father, One Hail Mary, and One Glory Be)  
You also should do one of any of the following devotionals that day:
  1. Stations of the Cross
  2. Saying the Rosary within a Church or (Outside a Church within a family group, pious union, or someone else)
  3. Spending at least a half-hour reading Scripture
  4. Spend at least a half-hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament.
  5. Remember our Parish is open during office hours, and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle is available. Remember, an indulgence isn't a quick ticket to Heaven but an opportunity for conversion for those seeking a closer relationship with Jesus Christ and the Church. As Saint John Paul the II once said, "The granting of an indulgence by the church is "the expression of the church's full confidence of being heard by the Father when, in view of Christ's merits and, by his gift, those of Our Lady and the saints, she asks him to mitigate or cancel the painful aspect of punishment by fostering its medicinal aspect through other channels of grace."
